Important information for all riders and parents

REGISTRATION: At the Clubhouse, Horse Health Declaration must be provided. Performance Cards for Official Classes, or registration number on nomination form, are required or rider will ride HC.

DUTY ROSTER: Will be provided with the draw.

TWO HORSE RULE: At the discretion of the organising committee, riders may enter 2 horses in the same of different heights within their age group. Each horse may gain qualifying results. Each horse will be placed in its class and is eligible for overall awards.

CONDITIONS:

- Horses must be fit for riding, wormed and in good health
- No alcohol to be consumed on the grounds
- No smoking is permitted on the grounds
- Inappropriate language or behaviour will result in disqualification at the judges' discretion
- Horses must be ridden at a walk when not competing or preparing to compete
- No dogs are permitted in the competition area and they **must be on a leash** at all times in the carpark
- No refund after competition commences
- Judges' decision is final
- All disputes are to be reported to the Technical Delegate and must be lodged in writing within 30 minutes of the event (accompanied by \$50 which is non-refundable if protest is lost)

RESERVATION OF RIGHTS:

The organisers reserve the right:

- to cancel any class or event;
- to divide any class;
- to alter the advertised times;
- to refuse any entry, with or without stating the reason;
- to transfer competitors between sections of a class;
- to combine classes if less than 3 competitors.

COMBINED GROUPS:

- Combined Group Criteria: Three (3) competitive riders make a group, and therefore are not combined.
- When one or two riders have been nominated for a class, or if after close of nominations, the number decreases, the Organizers have the right to:
 - Combine the group with the height above or below, i.e. 100cm with 90cm;
 - Groups are combined firstly within their age group i.e. 12 & Under 70cm with 12 & under 80cm
 - Only as a last resort with the height classes for 13years & over i.e. 12 & under 80cm with 13 & over 80cm;
 - Or if only 1 rider 120cm and only 1 rider in 110cm would then combine with 100cm.
 - Where there are less than 3 riders on the day in the highest class with nominations: Organisers combine classes:
 - EITHER: 1) as per rules for all groups as above; OR
 - 2) using Senior Rule, i.e. where riders in highest group are placed separately to riders in lower group – Refer to rule for Seniors for more detail. Riders to be informed on draw if Option 2 is being used.

- Jumping the Course: Example: Where 120cm combine with 110cm: The lower height jump their first round at 110cm; then course is adjusted to 120cm and these riders jump their first round. Same procedure applies for second round or jump off.
- Placings: Combined Groups are treated as ONE group for the purpose of calculating the result of each class and overall awards, i.e. Penalties and time judged equally, ignoring the different heights. Example:
 - Joey (120cm) 4 pen. 31.6 sec. 2nd
 - Bill (110cm) 0 pen. 35.0 sec. 1st
 - Henry (110cm) 4 pen. 33.4 sec. 3rd
- Qualifying results: are recorded in the same way.

DISCLAIMER:

Neither the organising committee of any contest to which these rules apply, nor the PCQ, accept any liability for any accident, damage, injury or illness to horses, owners, athletes, ground, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever.

BIOSECURITY:

In the event of horse movement restrictions, each participant will be responsible for the care, maintenance and cost of their horse/horses. Including and not limited to feeding, watering, and vet cost for the time of the restrictions.

COVID-19 REQUIREMENTS:

Any COVID-Safe directions of the Queensland State Government will be enforced as required. On entry to the venue **all attendees** agree to follow **COVID-Safe practices** aligned to the Queensland State Government recommendations. Do not attend if you or anyone attending with you is unwell.
