WHILE / WHEREAS (/ ALTHOUGH) + proposition
INSTEAD OF + NOM / + V-iNG
CONTRARY TO + what... / + NOM
UNLIKE + NOM
------ may not + Verbe ----- but

a) **UNLIKE** = Differently, as opposed to...

ex: Biden never interrupts people when they speak, <u>unlike</u> his opponent.

ex: Unlike my brother, I've never driven my Dad's car!

b) CONTRARY TO + NOUN or pronoun WHAT:

ex: He wasn't born in Paris, contrary to what he said...

ex: Contrary to popular opinion, JFK wasn't elected easily...

c) WHEREAS + clause = to express a contrast =
An opposition between the result of the actions expressed
about two persons, two objects, two ideas -

ex: <u>I</u> love meat and fish <u>whereas</u> <u>my sister</u> is a vegetarian! ex: In a village, everybody knows everyone, whereas in NYC, you can go unnoticed!

d) INSTEAD OF + Noun/pronoun OR Gerund or possessive adjective:

ex: He watched TV instead of doing his homework!

ex: I'd like meat instead of fish ...

e) ON THE CONTRARY - DIFFERENT FROM; adjective OPPOSITE

ex: Yes! They're twins, but Paul really insists on being <u>different</u> from Jim! (NB: <u>'different... than'</u> is frequently heard in the USA)

ex: He told you to turn right and you took the opposite direction!
