

ICEWORLD FIGURE SKATING CLUB 2019/20 Volunteer Program

The volunteer program has been updated to provide members with a clear system that aims to provide a greater range of funding opportunity to all members. In addition, the new program will be based on a rolling year; (ie: July 30, 2018 – August 1st, 2019 changing each month) The volunteer program is made up of three levels, each offering benefits depending on the number of hours volunteered.

Levels:

• Bronze:

All members start at Bronze level. The IFSC Association Rules require all members to volunteer for a minimum number of hours each membership year.

• Silver:

Members that volunteer a minimum of 10 hours or more.

Gold:

Members that volunteer a minimum of 20 hours or more.

NB Alternatively you can cook and donate a meal which is measured as 2 hours in any level

Benefits:

- Bronze level includes:
 - Member social events
 - Monthly fun skates
 - Club subsidised events, training and seminars
 - o IFSC State Team representative jacket (For QLD Championships levels only)
- Silver level includes:

Bronze level benefits plus the following:

- o Free skater ticket to the annual club presentation dinner
- o Opportunity to participate in special events and exhibition events
- o (may depend on additional level criteria)
- Gold:

Bronze + Silver level benefits plus the following:

Opportunity to apply for a club member funding subsidy as follows (please refer policy for details)

2019/20 Subsidy Options:

Subsidy A: Up to \$500 (International/Overseas funding)

- Skaters participating in an international seminar, training camp or competition held overseas
- Subsidy only for out of pocket expenses relating to travel, accommodation or entry fee
- May only be applied for once per membership year

Subsidy B: Up to \$300 (Domestic funding)

- Participation in a domestic event (not competition), camp or seminar hosted by IFSC or ISQ.
- o Participation in a domestic camp or seminar hosted by ISA
- ISA nominated skaters competing in ISA hosted international competition
- Subsidy only for out of pocket expenses relating to travel, accommodation or entry fee
- o May only be applied for once per membership year
- NB This does not include ISQ classes (weekly at the rink)
