A Note From the Pastor

Dear Trinity Family and Friends,

As we enter the Lenten season, we traditionally give things up. I suggested adding something rather than giving something up for Lent, on Ash Wednesday. We can add activities that draw us closer to God. These types of activities are called spiritual disciplines. They deepen our relationship with God and with each other. There are a lot of spiritual disciplines including prayer, meditation, good deeds, and more. I highly recommend adopting a spiritual discipline if you are giving something up. Matthew 12:43-45, "When the unclean spirit has gone out of a person, it passes through waterless places seeking rest, but finds none. Then it says, 'I will return to my house from which I came.' And when it comes, it finds the house empty, swept, and put in order. Then it goes and brings with it seven other spirits more evil than itself, and they enter and dwell there, and the last state of that person is worse than the first. So also will it be with this evil generation." When we cut something out of our lives it leaves a void that will be filled by something. Make sure it is something good.

Lent is the time of year we prepare for the Passion and Resurrection of Jesus. This year we will prepare by services from Mathew's Gospel Account. The Pastor's Bible Study will discuss the Lenten scriptures starting in third week of March. We will come together on Holy Thursday and Good Friday at 7pm each day. On Easter Sunday the Resurrection will be celebrated at a Sunrise Service (@6:00am) and our service at 9am.

Keep an eye on the bulletin and screens because we have a lot going on in the next few months and you do not want to miss anything.
