

ed by the NM Office of Substance Abuse Prevention and administered by the Pacific Institute for Research and Evaluation. Locally, the OSAP Program is housed with Village of Los Lunas DWI Program. The OSAP- Substance Use Prevention Program, works in conjunction with the Community Wellness Council to administer the survey to Valencia County Residents. Findings from this survey will be used to better understand substance abuse issues across New Mexico. The more New Mexico residents who complete the survey, the better NM OSAP can respond to the problems and areas of most concerns. We want to find out what community members know about (alcohol and drug) prevention efforts and to help identify substance abuse prevention needs in our community. It takes about 15 to 20 minutes to complete. We are giving away \$100 to 3 people every week. Must


