MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, May 9, 2019 in the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan with all councillors present.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on April 11th, 2019 were approved as circulated, the minutes of the Special Meeting held on April 18th, 2019 were approved as circulated, the Statements of Financial Activities for the month of April were accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council accepted a tender for construction of a road allowance and accepted a tender for construction on Hwy 361-12. Council authorized the purchase of a 40 foot shipping container and authorized a donation to STARS. Council accepted the provincial education mill rates established by the Province of Saskatchewan. An RFP was awarded to AECOM Canada Ltd for engineering services. Gravel crushing of 35,000 yards was also authorized. Council entered into an agreement for extraction and stockpiling of gravel for the 2019-2021 seasons and authorized a letter to be sent to Minister Ralph Goodale calling for Minister Goodale and the government of Canada to take immediate action and resolve the ongoing canola trade dispute with China.

One delegation was received.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

A number of road right-of-way applications were approved for wellsites, and powerline crossings.

Correspondence was received and filed.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 a.m.
