Since school started until September 10, 2013, we had expenses of \$4,759.11, mostly being Communication Copies, Staff Luncheon, PIN night supplies, and teacher enrichment. Bank deposits totaled \$2,563.85.

EXPENSES: As explained above our expenses were for our Staff Luncheon, Membership Drive needs, Teacher Enrichment, and Copy Costs.

INTERNATIONAL WALK TO SCHOOL DAY

Coyote Ridge Elementary School, along with several other Roseville schools, will be participating in International Walk to School Day (W2SD) on **Wednesday, October 9, 2013**. Funding from The City of Roseville Safe Routes Program will allow students, teachers and parents to join together with other schools around the world to walk (or bike) to school! Other special activities associated with the walk include a welcome rally & giveaways.

International Walk to School Day events promote healthy lifestyles among children by encouraging them to walk or bike to school. More activity means healthier kids. Events emphasize ways to make the daily trip to school safe and fun. When children walk or bike to school, they make new friends and become more familiar with their neighborhood. And with more students on foot, traffic around schools is reduced.
