

Preparation Guidelines

GENERAL PREPARATION GUIDELINES FOR ALL-CERAMIC RESTORATIONS SHOULD BE FOLLOWED (FIG. 1 & 2):

- Preparation should follow the anatomy of the tooth, providing at least the minimum thickness required for the respective restoration (Table 1). A 1.0 mm axial and occlusal reduction is considered ideal for full contour zirconia restorations.
- 2. A definitive finish line (shoulder with rounded internal line angles or chamfer) is recommended. Feather edge preparations are acceptable.
- 3. All sharp edges and line angles should be rounded.




