Plunge Requirements:

DO's

- *Must wear secure "lake" shoes not flip-flops or slideins. Remember this is a fishing lake, so there might be fish hooks or other objects hiding in the bottom mud.
 Therefore, the need to protect you feet.
- Another pair of shoes to wear after the Plunge most prefer something that will slip on easily.

DON'T's

 Don't dive in – This is a safety regulation that will be enforced by the safety team. Other than that, the Plunge is whatever you want it to be. The water is cold, and it may take your breath away for a moment.

THINGS TO BRING

- "Lake" shoes for wearing during the Plunge (see above).*
- 2 Towels one to dry with after the Plunge, and one to stand on while changing to your "street" clothing.
- Dry undergarments and "street" clothing to wear after the Plunge.
- A bag to hold your "street" clothing & valuables during the Plunge.
- Someone to hold your clothing/valuables bag while you Plunge.
- A plastic bag for wet clothing & shoes.
