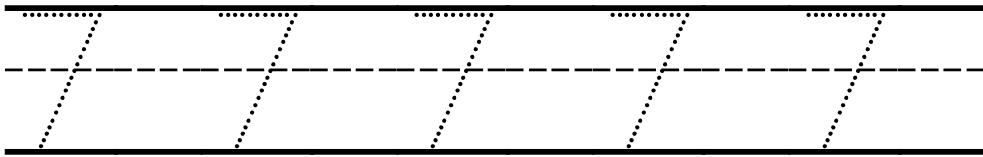


Unleavened Bread:

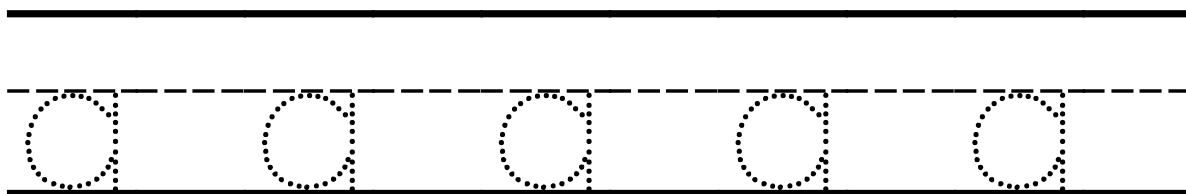
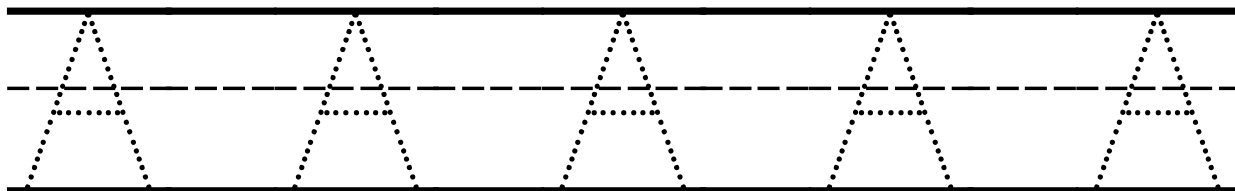



First Fruit:
