50TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE CANONISATION OF THE 40 MARTYRS OF ENGLAND & WALES

The challenges of faith that are present in our society, although expressed differently, would be recognised by the martyrs we celebrate today. Pope St. Paul V1 drew attention to this quality in our martyrs, in his homily at the Mass of Canonisation in 1970. He spoke of **the** *"interior quality of unshakeable loyalty to the* VOCATION given them by God – the sacrifice of their lives as a loving response to that call."

In a secularised society, one of the greatest expressions of faith we can offer to the world around us is simplepersevering fidelity to the Lord's discipleship. <u>ST. JOHN'S SEMINARY, WONERSH</u> This past week we have heard the news that St John's Seminary in Wonersh is to close in its present form. The Seminary has served the Church for 130 years and there is great sadness that formation must now end at the site.


Unfortunately there was no new intake this September. With the seminarian body numbering just 17 the community is small, with the building and staffing costs too high to sustain. Arrangements have been made for the remaining seminarians to join the community at Allen Hall, Chelsea in Sept 2021.

Archbishop John Wilson and Bishop Richard are committed to providing priestly formation that will serve the people of our Dioceses and parishes into the future. St John's will remain a legal entity so that consideration can be given to the ways in which the tradition of priestly formation established at Wonersh in 1891 will continue.

The Trustees of St John's are extremely grateful to rectors, staff and seminarians, past and present, and to all those who have supported the Seminary over the years. We ask our Diocesan church family to pray for vocations to the priesthood, keeping our seminarians in their thoughts and prayers over the coming months.

UPDATE ON COVID 19 <u>Visits to the Sick</u> Extraordinary ministers of Holy Communion should take particular care when visiting the sick (see guidance published by Bishop's Conference on 25th August 2020). They should not visit successive households in one session but should space home visits over a period of time, taking care with all aspects of hygiene between visits.

Some Reminders about Distribution of Holy Communion The very last thing you should do before distributing Holy Communion, is to sanitise your hands. Avoid touching your face covering or face whilst distributing Holy Communion and if you come into contact with a communicant by accident, please sanitise your hands.
