Sec. 23. License fee schedule.

There are hereby established the following annual license fees to be due January 1 and delinquent January 31 of each year for the licenses as listed below, with a penalty hereinafter set out for the failure to purchase said license from the City of Odenville, Alabama:

(1) Advertising. Each person engaged in the advertising business by whatever means:

Annually	\$500.00
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(2) Alcoholic beverages.

a. Liquor.

1. Lounge retail liquor license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a lounge retail liquor license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$300.00 for a Class I license and \$650.00 for a Class II license. This license allows for the sale of liquor, wine and beer at retail. There are hereby established two types of retail lounge liquor licenses in conformity with the ABC board regulations:
  - (i) Class I license allows the licensee to sell alcoholic beverages for both on-premises and off-premises consumption.
  - (ii) Class II license allows the licensee to sell alcoholic beverages only for off-premises consumption.
2. Club retail liquor license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a club retail liquor license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$250.00. This license allows the sale of liquor, wine and beer at retail by regulated memberships and dues organizations only.
3. Restaurant retail liquor license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a restaurant retail liquor license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$300.00. This license allows the sell of liquor, wine and beer at retail for on-premises consumption only. Establishment must comply with health department regulations and derive 51 percent of gross receipts from the sale of food.
4. Liquor wholesale license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a liquor wholesale license fee within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$300.00, plus \$200.00 for each warehouse in addition to the principal warehouse.
5. Liquor importer's license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a liquor importer's license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$250.00.
6. Liquor manufacturer's license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a liquor manufacturer's license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$250.00.
7. Distance limitations. No application for a lounge retail liquor license, club retail liquor license, or restaurant retail liquor license shall be consented to and approved by the city council where the location desired by the applicant is within 300 feet of any church building or grounds, school building or grounds or residential neighborhood.

b. Wine.



1. Wine on-/off-premises retail license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a wine on-/off-premises retail license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$75.00. This license allows the sale of wine at retail for on-premises and off-premises consumption.
2. Wine off-premises retail license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a wine off-premises retail license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$75.00. This license allows the sale of wine at retail for off-premises consumption only.
3. Wine wholesaler's license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a wine wholesaler's license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$275.00; plus \$100.00 for each warehouse in addition to the principal.
4. Wine importer's license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a wine importer's license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$250.00.
5. Wine manufacturer's license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a wine manufacturer's license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$250.00.
6. Definition of wine. The term "wine", as covered by this subsection, shall have the definition of table wine, or any wine, containing not more than 14 percent alcohol by volume.

c. Beer.

1. Beer on-/off-premises retail license. There is hereby an annual license fee for a beer on-/off-premises retail license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$75.00. This license allows the sale of beer at retail for on-premises and off-premises consumption.
2. Beer off-premises retail license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a beer off-premises retail license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$75.00. This license allows the sale of beer at retail for off-premises consumption only.
3. Beer wholesaler's license. There is hereby established an annual license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$275.00; plus \$100.00 for each warehouse in addition to the principal warehouse.
4. Beer importer's license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a beer importer's license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$250.00.
5. Beer manufacturer's license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a beer manufacturer's license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$250.00.
6. Beer/wine wholesaler's license. There is hereby established an annual license fee for a beer/wine wholesaler's license within the City of Odenville in the amount of \$375.00; plus \$100.00 for each warehouse in addition to the principal warehouse.
7. Definition of beer. The term "beer" as used in this subsection shall be interpreted to mean and include malt or brewed beverages of an alcoholic content not in excess of four percent by weight and five percent by volume.

d. Licensed establishments.

1. No application for wine on-/off-premises retail license or beer on-/off-premises retail license shall be consented to and approved by the city council where the location desired by the applicant is within 300 feet of any church building or grounds, school building or grounds, or residential neighborhood.



2. All establishments licensed to sell on- and/or off-premises alcohol pursuant to this subsection shall also comply with all requirements and regulations of the ABC Board, the State of Alabama and St. Clair County.
3. All persons, firms, partnerships, corporations, making an initial application for wine or beer licenses shall present said application to the city clerk-treasurer of the City of Odenville. Upon acceptance of same, the city clerk-treasurer shall refer the application to the city building and zoning inspector, chief of police and fire chief. These individuals shall investigate the applicant and the proposed location to determine the property of granting the license. If they collectively determine that the applicant is of good character and that the location meets all the requirements of any state or county laws, the applicable building, fire or other safety codes, they shall report their finding to the city clerk-treasurer who shall forthwith issue the desired license.
4. Any person, firm or corporation, not buying an appropriate license prior to the commencement of business, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, if found guilty by a court of competent jurisdiction, shall be fined not less than \$50.00 nor more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment not to exceed 180 days; and each day that the said license has not been purchased shall be a separate offense.
5. Licenses transferrable only upon approval of the city council of the City of Odenville. All applications submitted must include a \$250.00 application/processing fee.

(3) Banks and savings and loan associations. Each person, operating a savings and loan association, building and loan association, or bank, other than national banks:

Annually	\$125.00
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(4) Beer—Retail. See subsection (2)c of this section.

(5) Contractors. Each person engaged in the business of receiving orders, contracts, or subcontracts, for erecting, enlarging, or improving, repairing, or servicing any building, structure or appliance or making improvement to land or any other type of construction:

a. Group A—Prime contractors.

Annually	\$500.00
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b. Group B—Subcontractors.

Annually	\$150.00
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(6) Clubs—Private.

Annually	\$200.00
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- (7) Delivery. Each person who unloads, delivers, or distributes of any goods, wares, merchandise or produce up to \$75,000.00 in gross receipts. Over \$75,000.00 annual fee plus .09 percent.

Annually	\$100.00
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- (8) Entertainment, places of amusement.

- a. Except as otherwise set forth herein, and excluding those businesses or persons licensed pursuant to subsection b of this section, each person, firm, company, corporation or other entity engaged in the business of amusement or entertainment, billiard and pool rooms, bowling alleys, theaters, opera houses, moving picture shows, vaudevilles, amusement parks, athletic contests including wrestling matches, prize fights, box and wrestling exhibitions, football and baseball games (excluding athletic contests conducted by or under the auspices of any educational institution within the city or any athletic association thereof, or other association whether such institution or association be a denominational, a state or county or a municipal institution or association or a state, county or city school or other institution, association or school), skating rinks, race tracks, golf courses, or an other place at which any exhibition, display, amusement or entertainment is offered to the public or place or places where an admission fee is charged, including public bathing places, public dance halls of every kind and description within the city shall pay a license tax as follows:

Annually	\$50.00
Plus .09% of the gross receipts over \$10,000.00	

- b. Each person, firm, company, corporation or other entity engaged in the business of conducting or operating game rooms, amusement devices, music devices and other similar machines or devices shall pay an annual fee of \$100.00 plus the following:

1.	Up to four machines or devices	\$100.00
	Plus for each additional machine or device	\$25.00
2.	Each machine or device located in a licensed business other than a game room, up to four machines or devices	\$100.00
	Plus for each additional machine or device	\$25.00

The same license fees listed above shall apply to each person, firm, company, corporation or other entity engaged in the business of placing, leasing, renting or otherwise providing game machines or devices at





approved locations within the city, but it is not the intent of this section to require both the owner and the lessor to obtain a license for the same machine or device.

(9) Finance.

Annually	\$150.00
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(10) Fireworks

Annually	\$500.00
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(11) Insurance.

- a. Fire and marine insurance companies. Four percent of its gross premiums, less return premiums received by such company in the city. (Maximum authorized, Code of Ala. 1975, § 11-51-120.)
- b. Insurance companies other than fire and marine insurance companies. Twenty dollars, and also \$1.00 on each \$100.00 and major fraction thereof on gross premiums, less return premiums.
- c. Each insurance company other than fire and marine that did not do business the previous year in the city, shall pay a license fee of \$20.00 to the city before beginning business, but said license fee of \$20.00 shall be adjusted at the end of the year on a basis of \$20.00 and also \$1.00 for each \$100.00 and major fraction thereof of the gross premiums less return premiums received during the preceding year on policies issued during said year to citizens of the city.

(12) Lounges; beer parlors. See subsection (2)c of this section.

(13) Manufacturers. Each person engaged in the business of manufacturing, compounding, producing, fabricating, or processing shall pay a license tax as follows:

Annually	\$100.00
Plus .09% of gross sales, or fraction thereof	

(14) Merchants—Retail. Each person engaged in the business of selling goods, wares or products to others shall pay a license tax as follows:



Annually	\$50.00
Plus .09% of gross sales over \$10,000.00	

(15) Merchants—Wholesale. Each person engaged in the business of selling goods, wares or products to others for resale shall pay a license tax as follows:

Annually	\$100.00
Plus .09% of gross sales over \$20,000.00	

(16) Miscellaneous. Each person, dealer, association, or other business who shall in any capacity engage in or transact any trade, business, commerce, vocation, or profession for which no other license is specifically required by this Code shall not do business in the city or police jurisdiction until he has secured, from the city clerk-treasurer, a determination of a fair license for such business activity, and obtained the same.

(17) Motor carriers. For each person engaged in the business of maintaining or operating a motor bus terminal or operating any terminal or station facilities for transportation of passengers, property or express transported by motor carrier or airplane and each person operating any motor carrier which does business in the city or receiving passengers or freight for transportation for hire, between the city and other points in Alabama, license fee shall be as follows:

Annually	\$275.00
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(18) Parcels, Lots, Spaces for Rent

Mobile Home Lots, Campground, RV, Trailer, Travel Spaces

\$100.00 base rate includes 10 spaces/lots, \$15 per space/lot thereafter. This rate is per location in the City limits and/or jurisdiction.

(19) Professionals. Each person engaged in any practice vocation, or calling:

Group A—Annually	\$500.00
Group B—Annually	\$350.00



Group C—Annually	\$150.00
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(20) Public utilities. Each person operating any public utility in the city such as electric light or power companies which supply electricity for light or power, gas companies, except telephone and telegraph companies, railroad, sleeping car companies, and express companies, shall pay to the city a privilege license of three percent of the gross receipts of said utility for the preceding year of business transacted in the city. (Maximum authorized, Code of Ala. 1975, § 11-51-129.)

**Odenville Utilities Board is exempt.**

(21) Railroads. Each railroad keeping a place of business within the city and engaged in operating a railroad for the transportation of freight or passengers or both to and from points within the state.

Annually	\$100.00
(Maximum authorized, Code of Ala. 1975, § 11-51-124)	

(22) Salvage Yards.

Annually	\$500.00
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(23) Schools. Each person conducting a school, kindergarten, or nursery as a business for profit shall pay a license tax on gross receipts as follows:

Annually	\$50.00
Plus .09 percent of gross sales over \$10,000.00	

(24) Services.

Annually	\$100.00
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All services such as barbershops, beauty shops, etc., shall have a license tax for each additional chair in the shop:

Annually, per chair	\$25.00
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(25) Telegraph companies.

Annually	\$37.50
Maximum authorized, Code of Ala. 1975, § 11-51-127	

(26) Telephone companies—Exchange.

Annually	\$210.00
Maximum authorized, code of Ala. 1975, § 11-51-128	
Long distance charge	
Annually	\$53.00

(27) Utility companies. Amount of license is state regulated. See Code of Ala. 1975, § 11-51-129. An amount equal to three percent of gross receipts of business transacted in the municipality for the pervious year.

(28) Warehouses. By square footage:

5,001—10,000 sq. ft.	\$200.00
10,001—20,000 sq. ft.	\$300.00

(29) Wine—Retail. See subsection (2)b of this section.

(30) License tax on motor vehicle storage. A license, privilege or occupation tax is hereby levied upon each person or entity which engages in the business of storing motor vehicles. Such license, privilege or occupation tax is determined as follows:

0—2 acres	\$500.00
More than 2 acres—Up to 5 acres	\$1,250.00
More than 5 acres	\$2,500.00

(31) Vendors. (Mobile, Temporary, Seasonal) Each person engaged in the business of selling goods, wares, food or products to others shall pay a license tax as follows.

Annually	\$50.00
Plus .09 percent of gross sales over \$10,000.00	



All Ordinances or any part of Ordinances for the City of Odenville, Alabama in conflict with the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed.

If any clause, sentence, section, subsection or provision of this ordinance is held invalid or inoperative the remainder of the Ordinance shall not be affected thereby.




