Greetings Family of God,

We have been looking at New Testament principles for giving on Sunday mornings. While we have very generous people, who know how to give, it is important to teach up and coming generations what Christian giving looks like from a Biblical perspective. Pastor's often shy away from this topic for all the reasons many people don't talk about politic and religion. It can sometimes be uncomfortable. However, we are a people called to embrace uncomfortable truth. I want to leave a short recap of what we have covered, so that we can pray and meditate on these biblical concepts as we evaluate where each of us is with our faithfulness in giving.

- Giving is not from compulsion v.12

  - 1 Tim. 6:17-19, Pr. 11:24
  - Sows bountifully

**Weather Cancellation of Church Services**

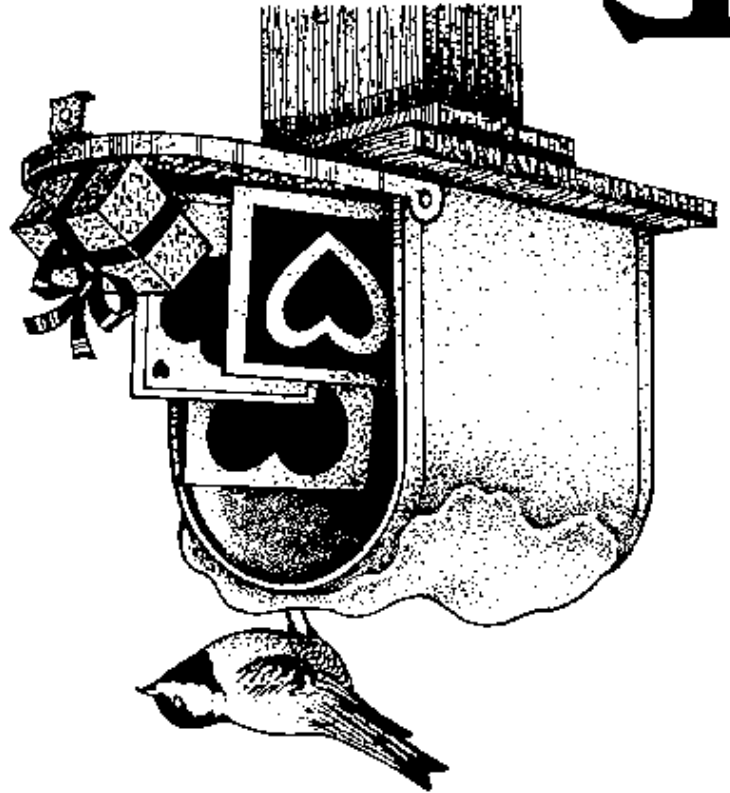
DECISION is usually made with Pastor, Moderator & Chairman of Deacons.
