- All quilts must also incorporate the Robert Kaufman Kona Color of the year (Crush) somewhere in your quilt. A 10-inch solid square of "Crush" will be provided for you to use in your quilt when you sign up for the challenge. Additional 10-inch squares, if needed, will be available for \$1 each.
- Please, no kits
- Artist statements are due no later than **Sept. 8**
- Please attach a four-inch hanging sleeve to the top back of your quilt
- Quilts will be displayed and judged during both meetings in November, with the winners being announced at the **Nov. 14** Night meeting
- Every participant will receive a participation gift when the quilts are displayed and judged.
- All quilts will be eligible to be hung at the Mid-Atlantic Quilt show if you so choose.
