



MEN... NO MORE COMPROMISING YOUR INTEGRITY

Integrity is a hot issue of discussion today. In society, because of the lack of integrity or compromising, people feel they cannot trust anyone anymore. Integrity is a big deal... churches are looking for godly leaders they can honor and follow. Our generation of young people needs role models they can follow without falling into a ditch.

When integrity is the topic of discussion, we are talking about a person's trustworthiness. It means what you say and what you mean are the same. It means that when you make a promise, you intend to keep it.

There is a daily decision that we all must make, that is, compromise or integrity! Our awesome Bible character, Daniel, was a man who stood out for the right reasons. He incarnated integrity! Daniel was confronted with compromise and conformity, but he refused to bow. Daniel 6:1-28 illustrates what it takes to be a man of integrity rather than a man of compromise and conformity. Daniel served with distinction and displayed public and private integrity through daily disciplines.

You may ask... what does it take to obtain the kind of integrity Daniel had?

- 1. Do not wait around for anyone or for your environment to get better before you make a move. Integrity has to do with who you are on the inside, regardless of what is happening on the outside. If your level of integrity is not what it should be, do not blame others or your circumstances.
- 2. Set your standards in advance. Decide on the things you will not compromise on according to God's standards before you find yourself in the middle of a

problem. We cannot wait until the action gets hot and heavy to decide on integrity.

- 3. Develop a daily devotional life. Make spending time with God the rule, not the exception. As we see in the case of Daniel, cultivating your walk with God will help you to become a man of integrity.
- 4. Find godly friends who will hold you accountable. Ask for God's assistance for those friends who will ask the hard questions about what you are doing and not doing.
- 5. Focus on God and not your circumstances.

If Daniel had focused on his circumstances, he would never have maintained his integrity. If you have fallen into compromise and conformity... through the grace of God, you can experience forgiveness and restoration. Man of God, do you want to see God's power operating on your behalf? Become a man of integrity who refuses to make excuses. The good news is that Jesus is in the edited room working with the videotape of our lives. Whatever is keeping you out of Jesus' editing room, do not excuse it. Bring it to Him, let Him take care of it, and live with integrity.


