What you should know

Mentors are carefully selected and undergo an orientation process. Orientation is provided by a Licensed Clinical Social Worker and facilitated by Elite DNA Comprehensive Therapy professionals.

The matching process is purposefully designed and supervised by a team of child specialist and behavioral health clinicians. Mentors do not play a role in the matching process.

Mentors are required to commit to a minimum of six mentoring sessions. Continuity and consistency are key elements to CRAM's success. Each mentoring session is supervised by adult mental health providers.

The means by which programs have positive effects on mentees appears to be largely through the consistent and affirming presence of mentors, and the clarity and predictability resulting from a clear program structure.

Positive experiences for mentors and mentees rely on various skills.

Clear communication plays a large role in mentors ability to effectively connect and make progress with students.
