

## MEETING REPORT

Council of the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32 held their regular meeting of Council on Thursday, June 10, 2021, at the Municipal Office in the R.M. of Reciprocity No. 32, Saskatchewan, with two councillors absent and Division 3 vacant.

The meeting was called to order at 8:00 a.m. with Reeve Arthur presiding.

Minutes of the Regular Meeting held on May 13<sup>th</sup>, 2021 were approved as circulated. The Statement of Financial Activities for the month of May was accepted as presented and the accounts were passed and approved for payment.

Council acknowledged receipt of a road closed notice, authorized advertising on the RM's Facebook, Twitter and website to inform the public that the top cut would begin the week of June 21, 2021 and that there would be no hay salvage program for 2021. Council authorized a grant to assist with the 2020 operating costs of the Alida Fire Department and authorized a cheque to be voided that was lost in the mail and approved a subdivision application.

Public Works Foreman, White, attended the meeting to discuss various matters pertaining to the workshop operation.

Four delegations were received – two salesmen, one by electronic means and one in person. Daryl Harrison, MLA for the Cannington Constituency and Acting Detachment Commander Tasha Reid from the Carlyle RCMP also attended.

Two road right-of-way applications were approved.

Correspondence was received and filed.
