Division Eligibility

Junior: A person who is 21 years or younger within the year.

Amateur: A person, 22 years or older within the year, who engages in dressage for the pleasure of it rather than for money. An amateur may not accept payment in any form such as cash, goods, discounts, services in kind of goods or services such as boarding or training, for riding, exercising, showing, training, assisting in training, schooling or conducting clinics or seminars aside from incurred expenses.

Open: Classification for a person not eligible as a Junior or Amateur. Juniors and Amateurs may participate in open classes.

Western: Western riders of Junior, Amateur, and Open status are eligible to participate.

- Office opens at 7:30 am Sunday.
- Show will start at 8:30 am Sunday.
- Dogs are not allowed on grounds.
- Food vendor will be open for breakfast and lunch on Sunday.
- Horses may arrive Saturday after 5:00 pm. All horses must be stabled; no showing out of trailers.
- Stall fees for Saturday/Sunday, \$30. Tack stalls \$15. Please if you use a tack stall you will be charged a fee. Bring your own bedding. Shavings only to be used for bedding. Stalls are not assigned.
- Covered show arena.
- Intro and walk/trot classes to be run in a 40m x 20m arena. All other classes to be run in a standard 60m x 20m arena.
- One ring only. Entries limited to the first 70 paid rides. Practice arena available.
- Safety helmets & heeled boots are required when mounted.
- English riders must use USEF approved bits.
- Western riders tack and appointments must conform to WDAA requirements.
