1. All schools will simultaneously participate in the said activity;

How to Register:

3. Assigned Documenter must take pictures of the area to be clean up as to "BEFORE, DURING, and AFTER" cleaning up; take record on the data (weight of each type) of garbage collected according to their classifications such as BIODEGRADABLES, RESIDUALS, RECYCLABLES, AND SPECIAL WASTE.
 4. Please submit the data collected to the Social Mobilization Unit for consolidation and submission to higher office including attendance sheet with AM and PM signature during the conduct of the activity.

Subject: **"BAYAN KO, LINIS KO!" NATIONAL CLEAN-UP DAY**

Date: September 5, 2016

1. Pursuant to Republic Act 9003 or the Ecological Solid Waste Management Act of 2000 and Presidential Proclamation No. 244, series of 1993 entitled, *Declaring September of Every Year as National Clean-Up Month and the 17th to the 23rd of September of Each Year as the World Clean and Green Week*, the Department of Education (DepEd) in partnership with the Department of Environment and Natural Resources (DENR) enjoins all schools through their Youth for Environment in Schools Organization (YES-O), Supreme Student Government (SSG), and other school organizations to actively participate in the National Clean-up Day on September 17, 2016 with the theme, "Bayan Ko, Linis Ko!"

2. This activity, to be done simultaneously with all schools, households, barangays or communities nationwide, is part of the Clean 500 Program for the Environment in the first 100 days of President Rodrigo R. Duterte and aims to kick start a cleanup day to be done every quarter, as follows:

- a. Every third Sunday of September, coinciding with the International Coastal Cleanup Day;
- b. Every January as part of R.A. 9003 anniversary and Zero Waste Month;
- c. Every April as part of the Earth Day celebrations; and
- d. Every June as part of Environment Month celebrations.

3. This National Clean-up Program targets three types of sites for clean-up, namely, Mountains and Watersheds, Urban and Rural Built-up Areas (such as but not limited to thoroughfares, roads, sidewalks, parks, public and private establishments, schools, churches, vacant lots, industrial and commercial states), and Coastal Areas and River Systems.

4. Participating schools must first register in the official Facebook page of the Basura Patrol Program of the DENR at <https://www.facebook.com/denr.emb.swmd/app/684336108254110>. A school, considered as one team, must fill up the necessary information in the registration form provided online. Team leaders can either be the school head or the club adviser.

5. The team leader or assigned documenter must also take pictures of the "Before, During, and After" activities and must record the data (weight of each type) of garbage collected. The data on waste collected must be uploaded on the Facebook page mentioned above with all the required information. The waste types or four (4) classifications shall be biodegradables, residuals, recyclables, and special waste.

6. The collected biodegradable waste must be composted and the recyclables will be processed or stored at the school or barangay MRF. The other types of wastes must be collected by the barangay or Local Government Unit for proper disposal.

7. Aside from submitting data through Facebook, same data must also be recorded by completing the Registration Form (Enclosure 1) and Reporting Form (Enclosure 2). A copy of each form must be submitted to the host barangay of the school and to the Social Mobilization Unit of the Schools Division Office.

8. The Social Mobilization Units with the support of the Division Information Officers shall take the lead in the advocacy, supervision, and documentation of this nationwide activity. A comprehensive report and consolidated data shall be submitted to the DepEd CAR Regional Office on or before September 22, 2016.

9. Members of the Regional Ecology Center (REC) from partner line agencies together with the Provincial Environment and Natural Resources Office (PENRO) or Municipal Environment and Natural Resources Office (MENRO) shall be mobilized to monitor and validate the activity. Members from DepEd, namely, Dr. Cresencio Gamay of the Education Support Services Division (ESSD) and Mr. Georoloy I. Palao-ay of the Office of the Regional Director (ORD) are hereby tasked to monitor specified municipalities during the REC Meeting. Identified municipalities with DepEd members are (Dr. Gamay) Lamut, Lagawe, and Kiangnan municipalities in Ifugao and (Mr. Palao-ay) Tuba municipality in Benguet.

10. Service/ compensatory overtime credits shall be granted to all teaching and non-teaching staff who will render service during said activity. Expenses incurred shall be charged against local funds subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

11. Immediate dissemination and compliance to this Memorandum is desired.
