

Fr. Gus' Corner

Catechetical Sunday September 19, 2021

- I. This year, the theme is:"Say the Word and My Soul Shall be Healed."
- What is Catechetical Sunday? On this day, those generous parishioners, Teachers/Catechists who hand on the Faith, including parents, grandparents, Catholic School Teachers and all adults are formally acknowledged and recognized and presented to the community.
- Catechetical Sunday is a wonderful opportunity to reflect on the role each one plays in handing on the Faith and be a witness to the Gospel.
- II. Growing up in Ghana in my boyhood years, (late 1960's into the 70's) there was no such thing as organized CCD/Catechism (as we call it back home).
- A boy/girl just accompanies the parents to mass every day or Sunday from early years, between 3 and 12 years, until such time the child suggest "Mom/Dad, I want to receive Holy communion," only then the parents would talk to the only one Catechist of the Church. When the Catechist has a good number of kids, then he or she would organize a formal catechism for a period of 3-5 months and prepare kids for the two sacraments:
- 1st Reconciliation and 1st Holy Communion and then later, the Sacrament of Confirmation. It was such in my case when after receiving 1st Holy Communion at age 10, that I told my father that "when I grow up, I want to do the work that the man in the long cassock does so that you all line up for communion from me every time you come to church." My Dad quickly asked, "You mean you want to become a priest?" To which I convincingly said "YES, if that is what he is called." CCD is always a good means/channel of igniting the Faith of a child which carries them into Adulthood.
- III. Let's continue to encourage our children and grandchildren to love our Religious Ed program which is so well organized. Let us show interest in what the program is ALL about.
