

Normally I do not title my pastoral letter but this one has a particular theme: What raising chickens has taught me about God and ministry. Our first experience with raising chickens came when Carter was in kindergarten. His teacher and our friend Mrs. Kinne would get eggs from the hatchery and hatched them in the brooder in her classroom. After the chicks hatch and are about a week old then she would look for a willing family to adopt the chicks. That year we were told (not asked) that Carter was going to be getting the chicks to take home. There were twelve little chicks that we were now responsible for and neither Melinda nor I knew the first thing about raising them. So we purchased a book and read up on it. The book helped a lot but there were a few things that it did not cover – like telling your 6 year old son that we have to butcher the chickens since they are broilers. After many tears and a few more tough conversations Carter understood and we bought some laying hens the next spring. Carter loved those chickens and we began to call him the "chicken whisperer."

Last month something that happens in nature all of the time but we somehow take for granted is one of our broody hens hatched four chicks. We have a rooster and know about biology but in the 8 years of having chickens that had never happened. It has been fun watching the mother hen care for her chicks. She would lift up her wing and the little chicks would run underneath, she would pick food out of the feeder with her beak and drop it in front of them, and she is very protective if you try to get close to her babies. In Matthew 27:37, God wants to gather together the children of Israel like a hen gathers her chicks under her wings. This is a powerful image of God and when you see that illustration in person it helps you see how God wants to gather all people together under the protection and safety of her wings.

Just like we were reluctant to have chickens because we did not know what we were doing, now we cannot imagine life without chickens. The same for being in the ministry. It was scary to make that leap, Melinda and I were unsure what would happen if it did not work out but thankfully God had bigger and better plans. Sometimes in ministry with all of our planning, organizing, and effort we end up trying to force things. Many times ministry happens organically as God is

already at work and looking for us to partner with where the Spirit is already moving. Raising chickens is not easy or without its share of work and money but the rewards are worth it. Ministry is the same, there is a cost involved but the rewards make it all worthwhile. I am looking forward to what God has planned for us as we continue to follow where the Spirit is leading.

Terry, council chair, called the meeting to order at 10:25 a.m.

Bobbi gave devotions from The Upper Room on Beyond the Galaxies.

Motion by Sandy; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Dean to approve the minutes of the May 20, 2021 Council Meeting as read by Karen Abrahams, Church Council Secretary. Motion carried.

Treasurer's report by Nancy Mathahs with a balance of \$14,011.12. Apportionments have been paid through July. Motion by Dean; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Karen Hove to acknowledge the Treasurer's report as presented by Nancy. Motion carried.

SPPRC will meet in August to settle salaries for the staff.

NOW Report by Bobbi. She had visited Becky Johnston.

A letter will be sent out from the church to members with the vacancies for 2022 on the Church Council. Pastor's Report: Our district name is now Camp Clear Lake District. Charge conference will be Sunday, October 10, 2021 at Wesley United Methodist Church in Mason City beginning at 2 p.m. Discussed the June 20<sup>th</sup> joint worship service at the Worth County Fairgrounds with Northwood; Asbury from Lake Mills; and First Lutheran Church of Northwood. Pastor discussed getting a small group together to study the Book of Psalms. More information to come later.

UMW Report by Karen Hove: A meeting was held on Wednesday, June 2, 2021 at 10 a.m. with Myra Bowman as our guest speaker. Health Report: Betty Chapin has decided not to be the churches Parish Nurse.

Men's Report with a balance of \$1,466.88.

Motion by Sandy; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Bobbi to accept the bid from Springer Construction for the sidewalk project at the church in the amount of \$43,100. Motion carried.

George Kesler Bequest in the amount of \$10,000 has been given to the church as a memorial trust fund. The interest received annually can be spent according to the vote of the council.

Trustee's Report by Sandy: The Bequest we received last year with a balance of \$611,360.42 less \$20,000 transfer to the Trustees Account to be used for ½ payment on the Sidewalk Project and a transfer to \$616.82 for the elevator safety check. Leaves a balance of \$590.744.10. Trustees Account balance is \$31,155.62.

Nancy handed out a one-page Emergency Response Plan. She will be checking on prices for posters to be put up in the church for the Emergency Routes to take in case of an emergency.

Motion by Karen Abrahams; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Karen Hove to purchase a \$100 visa card to be given to Carter Lanphere in appreciation for all the work he does in the video of the church services. Motion carried.

Next meeting date is Thursday, August 12, 2021 at 9:30 a.m.

Adjournment by Sandy; 2<sup>nd</sup> by Karen Hove. Motion carried.




