The entire show is synchronized to traditional and more modern Christmas music.

Even more music has been added this year.

Visitors of all ages will be awed by the display's RGB technology that creates larger-than-life trees, glowing snowflakes, dancing candy canes, mischievous elves, enchanting tunnels of lights, and much more.

In the warmth of their own vehicle, guests tune their radio dial to a dedicated signal and sing along to the sounds of the season synchronized to holiday lights.

Cost is \$30 per carload, up to 8 people

\$50 per carload, 9-15 people

\$75 per carload, 16-35 people.

Tickets will be honored in two timeslots – 6-8 p.m. or 8-10 p.m.

Height of vehicles must be NO MORE than 11 ft. tall to drive through the light display.

Guests should enter the Indiana State Fairgrounds at Gate 12, 1698 E. 42nd Street, Indianapolis, IN 46205.
