Storytelling Time ... Witnessing the Signing of SB 448 & SB 430

On Thursday, June 10, 2021, I accompanied Dr. Mary L. House, President & CEO of CHR, Inc., to the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) Local 357 Union Hall to witness the signing of Senate Bills 448 and 430 by



Nevada Governor Steve Sisolak. The two bills came from the 81st Legislative Session and will invest in Nevada's new energy economy and infrastructure while creating thousands of jobs.

The Governor was joined by Senator Chris Brooks, Assemblywoman Daniele Monroe-Moreno, Treasurer Zach Conine, Governor's Office of Energy Director David Bobzien, Nevada Department of Transportation Director Kristina Swallow, Nevada State legislators, labor leaders, business representatives, and community and environmental organizations.

Dr. House and I arrived early and were able to sit in the front row. The event began at I I:00 am and I could feel the excitement of everyone waiting to see these two bills being signed. As I looked around the room, I saw the electrical workers unified in their blue shirts; and, various community, business, and political representatives rejoicing as they gathered to take photos with one another. Then Governor Sisolak walked into the room to the roar of the crowd and a standing ovation. As I watched, I began to reflect on the numerous in-person and Zoom meetings, emails, text, and other social media outlets supporters used to amplify the clean energy initiative. I had a chance to catch a glimpse of the hard work supporters like Rudy Zamora with Chispa Nevada, Dylan Sullivan with NRDC, Dr. House with CHR, Inc., and countless others have put into this project. It was a proud day for everyone involved and I was honored to be in attendance. Thank you, Senator Brooks, for sponsoring SB 448 and Governor Sisolak for signing both bills. There is more work to be done; however, we celebrate what SB 448 and SB 430 offers to Nevadans:

Senate Bill 448 will accelerate transmission development, renewable energy, and storage, bolstering Nevada's clean energy economy, creating much-needed jobs, improving health and air quality for all Nevadans, and reaching emissions reduction targets.

Senate Bill 430 expands and makes structural changes to the State Infrastructure Bank. The legislation, coupled with a \$75 million appropriation of general obligation bonds included in the Governor's recommended budget, will ensure the bank can begin approving important infrastructure projects throughout the state.
