1. A MAJOR CONCERN

Your input is important. Please be assured that your name will not be given or attached to my future report on this matter. It appears that we have serious problems with state-level offices.

Example 1: In January 2007, a \$4,155,745 distribution was made to correct errors made in the 2006 allocation of CAGIT/EDIT taxes returned to Vigo County.

Example 2: The current address of the Taxpayers Association is now 46 months old. During this period of time (nineteen quarters), I have made approximately 25 attempts in getting the state of Indiana to correct our address, which has remained the same since June 2004. Some state agencies have it correct, and some apparently refuse to correct it, even when we use their "change of address" form. This leads to serious problems not always receiving important government mail.

Example 3: This negative is a personal experience, but it could be you in the near future. I completed my Form 1040 electronically last week and proceeded to do my Indiana IT40 last night. Using the eFile address found in the state's publications, the site could not be accessed. After many tries over several days, I finally got a connection on April 1st on 8:30 PM. After working about an hour through the various line items on the form and nearly finishing, a message popped up (paraphrasing), "We're sorry. A technical error has occurred and the system is overloaded." I was cut off without completing the task, and upon trying to return, the message given was "Site cannot be found."

Apparently, too many people were trying to do their Indiana tax return. Now we have thirteen days to file without penalty.

There are other examples of problems I have with the state, but for now, please let me know if you have a similar story on a state agency.

2. TAX AND GOVERNMENT COMPETITION 2009
