



GAME RULES

All games will be governed by National Federation Rules with the following exceptions:

Game Clock

- Stop clock on all foul calls, free throw attempts and timeouts.
- Clock will run on violations (officials reserve the rights to stop the clock on violations).
- During the final (1) minute of the 1st half, the clock will stop on all whistles.
- During the final (2) minutes of the 2nd half, the clock will stop on all whistles.
- Slaughter rule – (If a team is up “30” points or more in the game – clock will run except on timeouts. If at anytime, the lead goes under “20” points the normal game clock rules will be reinstituted)

Game Clock Time

- (16) Minute half’s - 9th grade – 12th grade (15u – HS/Open)
- (15) Minute half’s - 7th & 8th grade – (13u – 14u)
- (14) Minute half’s – 4th – 6th grade – (12u & below)
- (2) Minute half-time
- Overtime – “2” minutes – first overtime / Sudden Death - 2nd overtime

Forfeits

- A forfeit is granted when a team is not ready to play (10) minutes after scheduled game time
- Timeouts
- (2) “30” second timeouts per half (timeouts do not carry over)
- Timeout to each team during the first overtime period. Timeouts from regulation will not carry over.
- 2nd overtime – NO TIMEOUTS GRANTED – Sudden Death

FREE THROWS

Bonus free throws on the 10th team foul only (no 1 and 1)
Technical fouls – 2 foul

GAME BALL

- Home team responsible for providing the game ball and must be accepted by the referee and opposing team.
- Home team will wear a lighter color jersey than their opponent.
- Home team will sit to the left of the scorer’s table (when facing the scorer’s table)

SPECTATOR RULES

- We expect **“POSITIVE PARENT PARTICIPATION”** – simply stated parents must behave.
- As a coach and organizational leader we expect that all head coaches be responsible for parent behavior. If unable to control your parents we will have them removed with no refund.
- Verbal assaults, disruptive behavior, vulgarity, profanity and abusive acts towards the officials, staff, other spectators and players will be tolerated. Immediate ejection without refunds will be granted.
- The WE HOOP staff and officials will not communicate with parents about anything concerning the game, how its’ officiated, complaints about opposing coaches, etc. The head coach will handle all of these matters.
