Judging will be on appearance only. Taste testing will not be part of the judging criteria.

Judges will be made up from members of our special guests. Special guests are from Circle 10, sponsors, and persons that have helped the Pack but do not currently have children in the Pack

Prizes will be given for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place.

The 1st place cake will be auctioned off to the highest bidder. Money collected will be donated to friends of scouting.

Please bring a cake serving utensil. We had a shortage of those last year.
