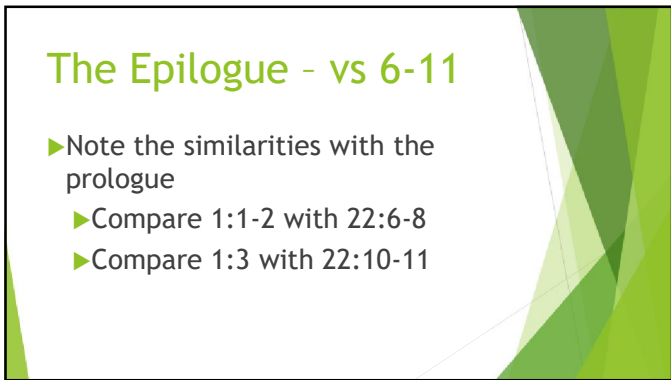
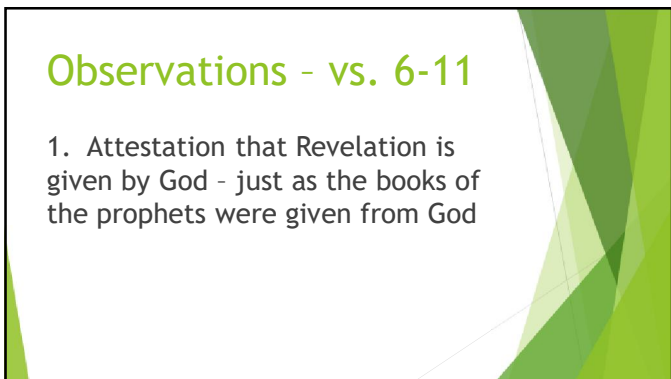

2. These words of God will soon come true!

- ▶ The anticipation of the expectation of the end
- ▶ An expectation that this could happen at any time
- ▶ Jesus promises that He is coming soon

▶ The time of Christ's coming is sudden so that there will not be time to repent. Now is the time to repent

▶ The expected "unexpectedness"

5. The prophecy is NOT to be sealed up

▶ This is opposite to Daniel - See Dan 8:26
