Observations - vs. 6-11

1. Attestation that Revelation is given by God - just as the books of the prophets were given from God

Observations - vs. 6-11

- 2. These words of God will soon come true!
- ►The anticipation of the expectation of the end
- ► An expectation that this could happen at any time
- ▶ Jesus promises that He is coming soon

Observations - vs. 6-11

3. Another mention that the time is near in vs 10

Observations - vs. 6-11

4. Let him who does wrong continue to do wrong

See Dan 12:8-10; Ez 3:27

- ► The time of Christ's coming is sudden so that there will not be time to repent. Now is the time to repent
- ▶The expected "unexpectedness"

Observations - vs. 6-11

- 5. The prophecy is NOT to be sealed up
 - ►This is opposite to Daniel See Dan 8:26

Observations - vs. 6-11

- 6. There is another warning against worshipping angels vs 8-9
- ▶See Rev 19:10; Acts 10:23-25
