### **September Reflection**

Well I have done it again, taken a book off the shelf and found a prayer, typed on a piece of paper long ago and forgotten. It's not just genes we inherit from our families but habits too....my Mum used to tuck birthday cards away, that were bought for the next family member or friend to receive, only to forget where she had 'tucked' the card as the date drew close and so, often, I was commissioned to buy another one for her just in time!

The words of the prayer I found from my bookshelf just leapt out at me from the page as I read it, the contents speaking to today's world and our own circumstances. As we continue to adjust to the way life is now, not just for us but our world, the small piece that we inhabit but beyond far beyond our imagining. So it's time now to share it with you and to reflect on where the pandemic leaves us as human beings...redefining what matters most.

Read and pray the prayer as it follows;

'Lord of the universe, look in love upon your people, pour the healing love of your compassion on a world that is wounded and dying. Send us out in search of the lost, to comfort the afflicted, to bind up the broken and to free those trapped under the rubble of their fallen dreams.'

Words written by Sheila Cassidy who was born in Cranwell 1937, a doctor eventually specializing in Palliative Care and for her outspoken defence of human rights imprisoned in Pinochet's Chile before returning to the UK. When I first read this prayer it must have been just right for that moment and worthy to be slipped into a book for safe keeping. At this moment of writing we are reeling from the news of an almighty explosion in Beirut where the rubble has truly buried many dreams, but of course there will be dreams of our own, crushed by circumstances beyond our power to change. Perhaps as we pray these words we can thank God for them and the woman who through horrendous suffering in Chile gave her skill and her faith through her writing to teach others how to care for one another through and at the end of life.


