

Year At A Glance 2020

Back to School Empowerment Youth Rally held on August 15, 2020, and the 2MEE Winter Coat Giveaway held in December 2020. The organization distributed **over 1,000 backpacks** filled with school supplies, **over 400 Coats** and other necessities to residents at the Talladega Housing Authority and the surrounding community.
