The Pennsylvania Uniform Construction Code (UCC) regulates the codes and standards of building projects in the Commonwealth. The UCC has been enforced since April 2004 across Pennsylvania. Over 90% of Pennsylvania's 2,562 municipalities have elected to administer and enforce the UCC locally, using their own employees or via certified third-party agencies (private code enforcement agencies) that they have retained. Connellsville now has a part time UCC administrator.












Did you know that Downtown Connellsville has created a downtown walking map? Walking distances are measured from the Comfort Inn Hotel. This map lists businesses that want to advertise to visitors that travel through or stay in one of our overnight lodging facilities. A business card size add is \$125 and the map is produced yearly. These maps are placed in the Connellsville Visitor's Center, Comfort Inn Hotel, Connellsville B&B, Connellsville Canteen and select restaurants and businesses throughout downtown. In addition to the walking map we also produced a rack card that lists restaurants in the downtown area. These rack cards are also placed in visitor areas. For the past several years Downtown Connellsville has paid for advertising in the Trail Guide. This trail guide is used throughout the Great Allegheny Passage and C&O Canal Towpath.



The Connellsville Visitors Center, located at Yough River Park, will be staffed 10 a.m.-5 p.m., weekends in April and May, then Tuesdays-Sundays in June, and daily in July and August. The center is seasonal and will be closed from October 2023 - March 2024. Downtown Connellsville has established a Welcome Center at the Connellsville Canteen, located at 139 West Crawford Avenue. It's open Monday - Friday 8 am - 2 pm all year.
