A big thanks must go to the members of the Tyabb CFA and their families who have been on a rotating roster with one of the station trucks working on the fires in Gippsland. This highlights the need for extreme care and vigilance over the coming months, because the potential is still very strong. Also, be aware that Fire Restrictions are still in force.



A reminder that the emptying of the "recycle" waste bin has reverted to the fortnightly cycle. The next collection will be either Thursday, 20th or Friday, 21st February - depending on where you live in Tyabb.

While we are on the topic of rubbish. The Shire's '**No Charge' Green Waste** disposal weekend has been brought forward and extended by an extra day.

It will take place at all Resource Recovery Centres (Tips) on Friday,

14th February to Monday, 17th February.

Green waste includes all types of garden waste and untreated timber. The event is open to Peninsula residents or ratepayers only - proof of residency is required.

Town Plan & Tyabb Airfield Precinct Plan

As mentioned in previous newsletters, our CRG members still await news as to when the next CRG meeting will be held. Whilst talking airfield, a reminder that the air show is just a month away; so a warning to all that have pets and other animals, maybe even yourselves, that are sensitive to loud noise - you may consider taking precautions. Also be aware that there may be some practice flights leading up to the day with related noise.

We are also still awaiting a briefing on the promised Airfield Master Plan and Noise Management Plan.

Road Safety

As our local schools have started for the first term, remember the morning and afternoon school zone speed restrictions are now active - **40kph**.

After an extended quiet time of no trains, they are now back, so take care at the numerous level crossings along the track from Stony Point to Frankston.

With the fickle Victorian weather, in particular the heavy rain squalls which can develop quickly, make allowances: slow down, be patient and make yourself visible by turning on your headlights. With the increased volume of traffic we all need to be far more careful.

Fire Restrictions



The Fire Danger Period is when CFA restricts the use of fire in the community. This is to help prevent fires from starting. CFA declares the Fire Danger Period for each Shire or Council at different times in the lead up to the fire season. It depends on the amount of rain, grassland curing rate and other local conditions.

The Fire Danger Period for Tyabb is between 16th December, 2019 and 1st May, 2020.

- * Animals will appear lethargic, unresponsive or confused
- Birds may pant with their mouths open & hold their wings out away from their body
- * Possums and koalas may come down to the ground seeking water during daylight hours
- In serious cases, animals may present unconscious or convulsing


