



SIMULTANEOUS EARTHQUAKE DRILL (NSED)**

SUBJECT : **Conduct of the 2017 2nd Quarter Nationwide
Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED)**

DATE : June 8, 2017

Relative to the Memorandum No. 76 s.2017 dated 1 June 2017 from the National Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council, the conduct of the 2nd Quarter Nationwide Simultaneous Earthquake Drill (NSED) will take place on June 29, 2017, 2:00 PM at UM Bolton Campus, Bolton St., Davao City. The drill will test the contingency plans of government agencies for an earthquake with the impact of a 7.2 magnitude in the National Capital Region (NCR), Region III and Region IV-A. With this, all schools and DepEd offices are directed to conduct Earthquake Drills simultaneously.

Herewith is the list of things to do in preparation for the earthquake drill;

- Connect with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMC) for an orientation on earthquake to understand intensity and possible impacts. Discuss preparedness measures.
- Map out personnel/ learners and contact numbers.
- Determine communication flow among offices/ schools and overall command system.
- Determine personnel/ learners with special needs in case of an earthquake; assign focal persons within the particular office/ classroom to take charge of those personnel/ learners with special needs.

- Put up signage for evacuation routes and safe places to gather and/or evacuate to.
- Ensure that everyone knows what to do during and after an earthquake.
- Ensure family reunification protocol in the school.
- Conduct post evaluation of the drill.

Reports of the Drill conducted will be submitted by respective schools to the Division DRRM for consolidation. All consolidated reports (Annex 1. Consolidated Report NSED) will be submitted to the Region DRRM copy furnished Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Service through email address, drmo@deped.gov.ph on or before 7 July 2017 (Friday).
