1980 Leyland Moke

Our father son Moke project began when we found a genuine 1980 Californian moke in a paddock at Glenreagh. We also found another moke in Armidale but when they came back from the sand blasters they were totally rusted out.

After a further search for a moke we found a good body. after an investigation, it was discovered that the moke came from Lord Howe Island which was used as a hire car. We then purchased the car in November 2008 and started restoration under very tight budget.

With every nut, bolt and washer removed, it was painstakingly paint striped back to bare metal. The underside of the floor and guards were soda blasted which was more cost effective than paint stripper, and far easier. There were only two areas of rust evident, in the floor near the battery compartment and on either side of the windscreen. New panels were made and welded in place. The entire car was etched primed then painted in Devil Yellow two pack. It was essential that we retained the rough details of the car, leaving the spot weld indentations and rough welds showing through the paint as per original.

Both the front and rear sub frames have been completely stripped and powder coated along with all suspension arms. They have been reassembled with new bearings, seals and rubbers. All nuts and bolts in the entire car have been replaced with stainless steel. Any parts that cannot be replaced with stainless have been nickel plated using a home plating kit. You can get carried away with one of those. We have even plated the brake springs.

Although originally the car had a hard top, we opted for the real moke experience using the rollbar with the topless experience. The rollbar, windscreen surround, side screens, dash panels, front grill and wheels have all been powder coated silver and white. Powder coating gives the advantage of a tough, durable yet professional finish. The current engine is actually from the Armidale moke and will be used as a club car. It has low mileage and was only been cleaned and repainted, though carby, dizzy etc have been rebuilt with new parts for reliable operation. Both seats have been renewed and despite their appearance they are quite comfortable. The car is far from finished and many more hours of Moking fun still is still to go. Thank you for taking the time to admire our car.
