A View of Events that Include Job – We agree with Bible historians that say the Book of Job was written before the LORD God gave Moses the Law and Commandments. It is obvious also that God waited until the time of Moses to describe "The Creation"! However, Job spoke about the fossil record, which we today refer to as "the prehistoric animal, or creature evidence" (refer to Job Chapters 40 and 41). And through Job there is no information of creation, other than the observation that the Spirit of God (the Holy Spirit) revealed the existence and subsequent extinction of prehistory creatures to Job!

The Book of Exodus explains that God spoke face-to-face with Moses; and this Bible student is not aware that God had such a relationship "of this sort" with any other person until Jesus. But all others the LORD God spoke to was by angles, unction(s) of the Holy Spirit, dreams & visions, and prophecy!

On two occasions (when God gave Moses the first and second set of stone tables: Exodus 24:18 and Deuteronomy 10:10) we see that Moses was kept safe on Mount Sinai forty (40) days and forty (40) nights in the pillow of cloud by day and pillow of fire by night wherein the presence of God abode among Israel. Thus, the children of Israel were protected when God spoke from within the cloud; else they would have died being exposed to the presence of God. But Moses remained alive even when God communicated and fellowshipped with him in the cloud!

We conclude that the LORD God instructed Moses about the Creation and hosts of other subjects he addressed and recorded in the five (5) books called the Pentateuch (Genesis, Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, and Deuteronomy)!

So then, from the vantage point of Job we get a glimpse of the past and see evidence of prehistory creatures God created going the way of extinction (*refer to Job Chapters 40 and 41, again*). And when Job (*in his text*) looked to the future we see in the distance, Mount Sinai, and the Law; the Cross of Christ Jesus; the second coming of Jesus; and the Day of Judgment where Job says:

- Job 19:25 For I know *that* my redeemer liveth, and *that* he shall stand at the latter *day* (*or end of time*) upon the earth:
- Job 19:26 And *though* after my skin *worms* destroy this *body*, yet in my flesh shall I see God:
- Job 19:27 Whom (God/ Jesus, my redeemer) I shall see for myself, and mine eyes shall behold, and not another (appearing to be me, or like me); though my reins (awareness/ purpose of continuing) be consumed within me (first, then resurrection?).

(As things are naturally, we know that Job could not have read about the resurrection of dry bone according to Ezekiel Chapter 37, or any of the other scriptures concerning resurrection of Jesus first; then resurrection of His believers/followers. But Job (by leading of the Holy Spirit) has definitely come to the same conclusion on resurrection and reconciliation as we have today, would you agree?). See if our timeline below clarify and adds to the explanations:

Timelines & Prophecies

• Eternity Past until the Initial Creation – Book of Genesis 1:1

- Times, Events, and Prehistory Life before the creation of Adam: In my mind Job spoke more <u>specifics</u> about the prehistory time than any other Judeo Christian Bible figure (see Job 40:15 through 40:24, and 41:1 through 41:34). Moses (writing as God instructed him in Genesis 1:20 through 1:25) made no distinction between animals (and/ or creatures) created, and those created prehistoric. But for us today, it is impossible to deny the fossil evidence of such prehistory creatures and their times of existence; but reliable dates are unknown, and none are given in Scripture! Genesis 1:2 through 1:25
- About Six Thousand Two Hundred (6200) Years Ago: The Creation of Adam (Man in the image of God; never done before!?) Genesis 1:26;
 And then Physical Life continued, without Life of the Spirit even after the man, Adam sinned Genesis Chapter 3 forward ...
- Pre-flood Era Ending at Noah Genesis 1:27 through 7:24 (*about 2510 B.C.*)
- The Book of Job Written; just prior to, and/ or about the time of Abraham Genesis 11:10 through 11:32 (about 2400 to 2000 B.C.)
- Beginning Families (Abraham & Sarah) of the Chosen People of God Genesis 11:26 through Genesis 23:20 (about 2222 to 2122 B.C.)
- The Families of Isaac, and Jacob Genesis Chapter 24 through Genesis Chapter 50 (*about 2100 to 1950 B.C.*)
- Moses is born, Mount Sinai recorded: The Law is given (describing the sacrificial salvation/ reconciliation/ atoning work(s) Messiah, Christ Jesus shall accomplish at his visitation); the children of Israel are delivered out of Egyptian bondage unto inheritance of their promised land The Books of Exodus, Leviticus, Numbers, Deuteronomy, Joshua, and Psalms (about 1575 to 1425 B.C.). Then the Books of Judges and Ruth (about 1400 to 1000 B.C.)
- First Kings of Israel: Saul; David; Solomon The Books of 1 & 2 Samuel, 1 & 2 Kings, 1 & 2 Chronicles, Psalms, Proverbs, Ecclesiastes, Song of Solomon (about 1075 to 950 B.C.)
- Israel split into two Nation: Nine (9) tribes become Samaria (or Ephraim in the North). Judah, Benjamin, and Simeon become the Nation of Israel in the South, or Judah. All the tribes were required to worship in the Temple at Jerusalem since the reign of King David! The Books of 1 & 2 Kings, 1 & 2 Chronicles, Amos, Jonah, Hosea, Isaiah, Micah (about 980 to 722 B.C.)
- The Northern Kingdom of Israel's tribes (*Samaria*/ *Ephraim*) were destroyed by the Assyrians in 722 B.C.; **Judah**, the Southern Kingdom of Israel's other three (3) tribes; Jerusalem and the Temple at Jerusalem were destroyed by Nebuchadnezzar of Babylon in 586 B.C. The Books of 2 Kings, 2 Chronicles, Isaiah, Obadiah, Nahum, Habakkuk, Zephaniah, Joel, Jeremiah, Lamentation, Daniel, Ezekiel (*about 722 to 586 B.C.*)
- The Northern Kingdom/ Samaria/ Ephraim ceased being a nation forever! But the LORD God restored the Southern Kingdom/ Judah/ Jerusalem after seventy (70) years in exile; and established the prophetic arrival time of Messiah, the Lord Jesus Christ (bringing life in the Spirit; the Holy Spirit and life eternal) The Books of Isaiah, Joel, Jeremiah, Daniel, Ezekiel (about 586 to 516 B.C.); Then the Books of Esther, Haggai, Zechariah, Ezra, Nehemiah, Malachi (about 530 to 400 B.C.)

- Visitation of Messiah; *Deuteronomy 18:15 through 18:22*: The birth, ministry, death (*sacrifice on the cross*), and resurrection of Jesus the Christ! His Church is established; believers and followers spread the good news of the grace of God offering eternal life to whosoever will come to Him through Messiah, Jesus according to *John 3:16*! The New Testament Books (*approx. 6 4 B.C. to 68 A.D.*)
- The Second destruction of Judah in 70 A.D.: Read again scripture texts in Matthew 24 Verses 1 through 44, and the following associated references: Luke 19:37 through 19:44; Daniel 12:11 and 12:12; and
 - o (Ezekiel Chapters 38 and 39, Zechariah Chapter 14, Revelation 11:15 through 11:19, Revelation 16:16, Revelation 19:11 through 19:21. These are all the same approximate time frame!)
- Today in (2017 A.D.) a majority of Old Testament, Judeo Christians Prophecies have already been fulfilled! But those prophecies remaining, and yet to be fulfilled are restated with greater clarity, and increased urgency in New Testament, Judeo Christian Texts. The four Gospels, Acts, Apostle Paul's writings, and The Book of Revelation are "crown jewels" among them!
