Grade Level Reports:**3rd Grade: Mrs. Puente**

- 3rd Grade is moving right along with all their studies. Students are doing well, becoming more responsible for their own learning, and are proud of their GROWTH that they are making in all their test. The 3rd grade teachers would like to thank all the parents for their support that we have received throughout the school year--it is greatly appreciated!
- In Math, students have been learning all about Fractions! We are currently going over what Equivalent Fractions are as well as how to Compare Fractions. Students will be taking their next CFA (test) at the end of next week, and we will celebrate their growth with a Growth Party scheduled for December 15th.
- In Science, students have been having fun learning about the Planets, the Solar System, and the Sun and Moon. We have been able to create some cool crafts and enjoy some edible experiments (Moon Phases with Oreos)!
