#### **OBIECTIVES. ACTIVITIES & REVIEW OF PROGRESS**

The main object of the League of Friends is to benefit the patients and former patients of Townlands Hospital. This is achieved by fund raising, subscriptions, donations and, legacies.

#### **FINANCES**

The League's Bankers are NATWEST Bank, Henley on Thames, Oxfordshire. The independent Examiner is Mr. | Maynes, a Chartered Accountant. The Treasurer's Report, set out overleaf gives a review of the Leagues financial activities and should be read as part of this report.

#### STATEMENT OF RESERVES POLICY

During the year past, the National Savings Account operated through the Post Office became unwieldy, as they turned it into a postal only account with none of the support mechanisms for enquiry and correspondence in place. Alternative accounts for the now substantial funds were sought, and it was decided to open an account with CCLA, the Specialist investment management for charities, faith organisations, and local authorities. CCLA Investment Management Limited (Registered in England No. 2183088) is authorised and regulated by the Financial Services Authority.

This account pays a slightly better interest rate than NS&I and is easier to administer. The balance in the account is now £30000. Interest from the Endowment Fund, together with other income, net of expenses, is taken to a General Purposes Fund to provide resources to cover future donations to the Townlands Hospital as and when the need for equipment for the Hospital arises.

I am pleased to present the attached accounts for the year ended February 28th 2013.

The current Account includes over £9400 for The Townlands Action Group. This has remained dormant for the last 2 to 3 years in its separate Bank Account.

Donations include £2,000 from The Phillimore Estate . Additionally, £23,584 was donated as a legacy from the estate of the late Gerry Andrews,

Fund raising this year was only from the Charity Boxes as there was no Christmas Party.

An appropriate amount of money was invested in some marketing collateral; banners, badges etc.which will be re useable going forward. Additionally, the Website provides us with a contact and donation point on the Web. A recent hit was a member informing us that they no longer pay income tax. The Committee continues to review fund raising methods for the future.

In view of low interest rates and price inflation, it again behoves the Charity to dispense funds now rather than later, and this ambition has been achieved, meeting all requests from Townlands for special equipment and services, such as the Ultra Low Bed, and Aphasia Testing Software. We continue to pay for the delivery of Newspapers to the common room, a service much appreciated by the patients as is the Occupational Therapy Van which we continue to support.
