New Code Yellow Alert orders for all of Manitoba came into effect on September 3.

- Religious services may be held with 50 per cent of capacity or 150 people, whichever is greater.
- The gathering limit for funerals, weddings, baptisms and prayer vigils for the deceased is 50 people or 50 % of capacity, whichever is greater.
- Masks are mandatory indoors.
