## Dynamic Dresdens Workshop

*The class will cover several different variations of edge finishes as well as a variety in the number of blades in a Dresden Plate. The size and design variations are endless! You will learn to sew the plates by machine and mix and match your edge finishes. Designed to be a technique class, you will determine how many plates and what sizes, finishes and layout you desire. Once your Dresden is created it will be appliquéd to a background. Again – how you choose to use your Dresden blades will be totally up to you!!*

### Supply List: (the basics)

- At least 1 Dresden Style Ruler (they come in a wide variety of degrees and lengths); Which one? Depends on what you want to make! Minimally the Easy Dresden Ruler or the Creative Grids 18° ruler.
- Rotary Cutter and Mat
- Regular Sewing Supplies (rulers, machine, threads, scissors, pins...)
- Personal Pressing set-up is helpful. (need a nice wool mat – order one for \$25 – 13 ½" x 13 ½" – perfect travel size)

### Fabrics:

- 5 fabrics – ½ yard each (Can be print, solid, blender, whatever you like – contrast is good and they need to play nice together!)
- Extra fabrics to try extra techniques – Just grab a bunch of FQ's to play with (in this case, more IS better!)
- Background Fabrics – at least 1 yard to get started – but really varies by what you plan to do with your Dresden Plates!

Additional supplies helpful but not required: (they vary by technique – I'll be teaching several different options!) How many different techniques do you want to try?





