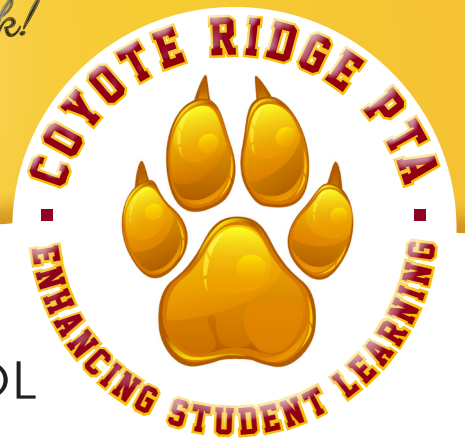

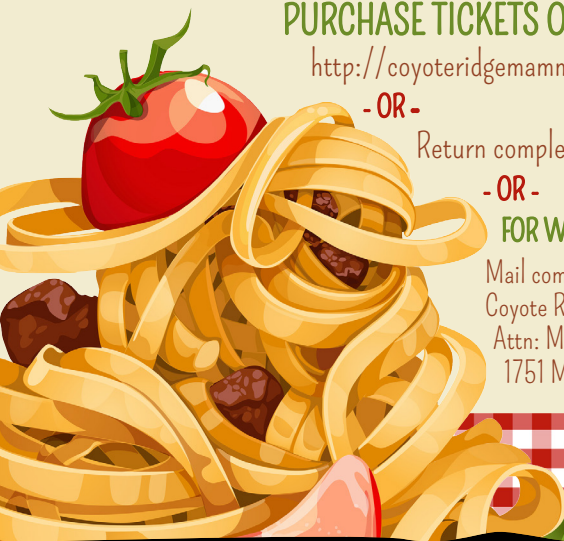

TREASURER'S REPORT

We are halfway through the PTA fiscal year. As of our January Executive and General PTA meeting, total year to date (YTD) expenditures were \$26,658.42 and YTD income was \$35,990.23. The net income for Fall Carnival was \$5,359.64. Box tops brought in income of \$1,507.40. Great job – keep saving those box tops! Expenses that have occurred since the last newsletter include staff appreciation \$606.58, copies and communication \$516.64, insurance \$216.00, classroom enrichment \$593.41, movie night \$181.93, spirit wear \$1,660.00 (100%

offset by income for sale of the shirts), family night Sami's Circuit \$350.00, membership drive incentives and supplies \$133.17, and bank fees \$48.00.

We have one more fundraiser coming up in March - Mamma Mia Magical Evening. Come out and support your PTA and have a family fun night!

FOOD ALLERGIES AND FOOD LABELS

The Food Allergen Labeling and Consumer Protection Act (FALCPA) requires that the labels of foods include the top 8 allergens within the ingredient section. However, DID YOU KNOW...The use of advisory labeling (i.e., precautionary statements such as "may contain," "processed in a facility that also processes," or "made on equipment with") is voluntary and optional for manufacturers. There

are no laws governing or requiring these statements, so they may or may not indicate if a product contains a specific allergen. Since these warning statements are currently not required by law, one can never be 100% sure if a food is free from possible cross contamination with a food allergen. Take a moment one day and read a few labels...can you translate the ingredient names?, can you find any allergens listed?, did the manufacturer include any optional precautionary statements? Consider this info when bringing food items into your child's classroom or when spending time around a family with a food allergic child.
