TO THE PEOPLE OF GOD IN THE ARCHDIOCESE OF NEWARK

Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ!

Pope Francis launched a two year “synod on synodality”, a call to all the members of the Catholic Church across the world to enter a process of listening to the Holy Spirit and to each other in order to discern the path we must walk together. The word “ synod” coming from Greek words meaning “same road,” synod and synodality are expressions of the fundamental mystery of the Church: People who are gathered from every corner of the earth to be “a chosen race, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, a people of his own, so that you may announce the praises” of him who called you out of darkness into his wonderful light(1 Peter 2,9). The present synod will take place in three stages: every diocese of the world is expected to promote a special time of prayer, listening, dialogue and recommendations; will continue at national and continental assemblies of Catholics. Finally, in October 2023, bishops and others will gather in Roma with the Holy Father to chart the future of our Church.

Who can participate in this synod this just for the clergy? No. All of us baptized are invited. Pope Francis never tires of reminding us that the participation of all must be an undeniable commitment of the whole Church. As a result of the diocesan consultation, a report will be written that will collect our voices. But the most important thing will not be answering a questionnaire or attending a meeting, but living synodality , every parish will have the opportunity to participate in this important moment in the history of the Church. But they will also be concerned with voices from the “periphery, voices that throughout the church and we need to listen that is, experiencing Church as walking with others. Let us begin a time of prayer and listening. A time in which all-bishops, priest, deacons, men, and women religious and laity- will try to answer two fundamental questions: How are we living this “Walking together” in our Archdiocese and what steps does the Spirit invite us to take in order to grow?

AL PUEBLO DE DIOS EN LA ARQUIDIOCESIS DE NEWARK

¡Gracia y paz a ustedes de parte de Dios Padre y de nuestro Señor JESUCRISTO!

El Papa Francisco inauguro el “sínodo sobre sinodalidad”, que durará dos años. Sera un llamado a todos los miembros de la Iglesia Católica en el mundo entero a iniciar un proceso de escucha al Espíritu Santo y entre si para discernir el camino que deben hacer juntos. La palabra “sinodo” formada por dos palabras griegas que significan el “mismo camino”,sinodo y sinodalidad son expresiones del misterio fundamental de la iglesia: personas provenientes de todos los confines de la tierra se reúnen para ser”una raza elegida, un reino de sacerdotes, una nación consagrada, un puelo que Dios hizo suyo para proclamar sus maravillas; pues el los ha llamado de las tinieblas a su luz admirable.(1 Pedro 2,9). El presente sinodo se desarrollará en tres etapas: se espera que todas las diócesis del mundo dediquen un tiempo especial a la oración, la escucha, el diálogo, y a hacer recomendaciones; este diálogo continuará a nivel nacional y continental. Finalmente, en octubre de 2023 obispos y otras personas se reunirá en Roma con el Santo Padre para trazar el futuro de nuestra iglesia.

¿Quién participara en este sinodo? ¿Solamente el clero? NO. Todos los bautizados estamos invitados. El Papa Francisco no cesa de recordarnos que la participación de todos debe ser un compromiso innegable de toda la iglesia. Como resultado de la consulta diocesana, se redactará un informe que recoja nuestras voces. Pero lo más importante no será contestar un cuestionario o asistir a una reunión, sino vivir la sinodalidad en nuestra Arquidiócesis. Cada parroquia participara en este importante momento en la historia de la Iglesia, pero también se preocupará de que sean escuchadas las voces de la “periferia” unas voces que con frecuencia pasan desapercibidas en nuestras conversaciones. El Espíritu Santo se esta moviendo por toda la Iglesia y necesitamos escuchar su voz.

Comencemos este tiempo de oración y de escucha, Un tiempo en el que todos, obispos, sacerdotes, diáconos, religiosos y religiosas y laicos, trataremos de dar respuesta a dos preguntas fundamentales: ¿Como estamos viviendo este “caminar juntos en nuestra Arquidiócesis y que pasos nos invita a dar el Espíritu para crecer?

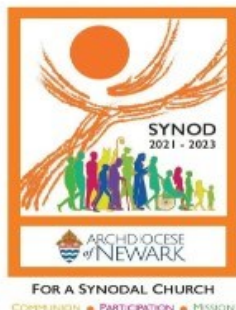
