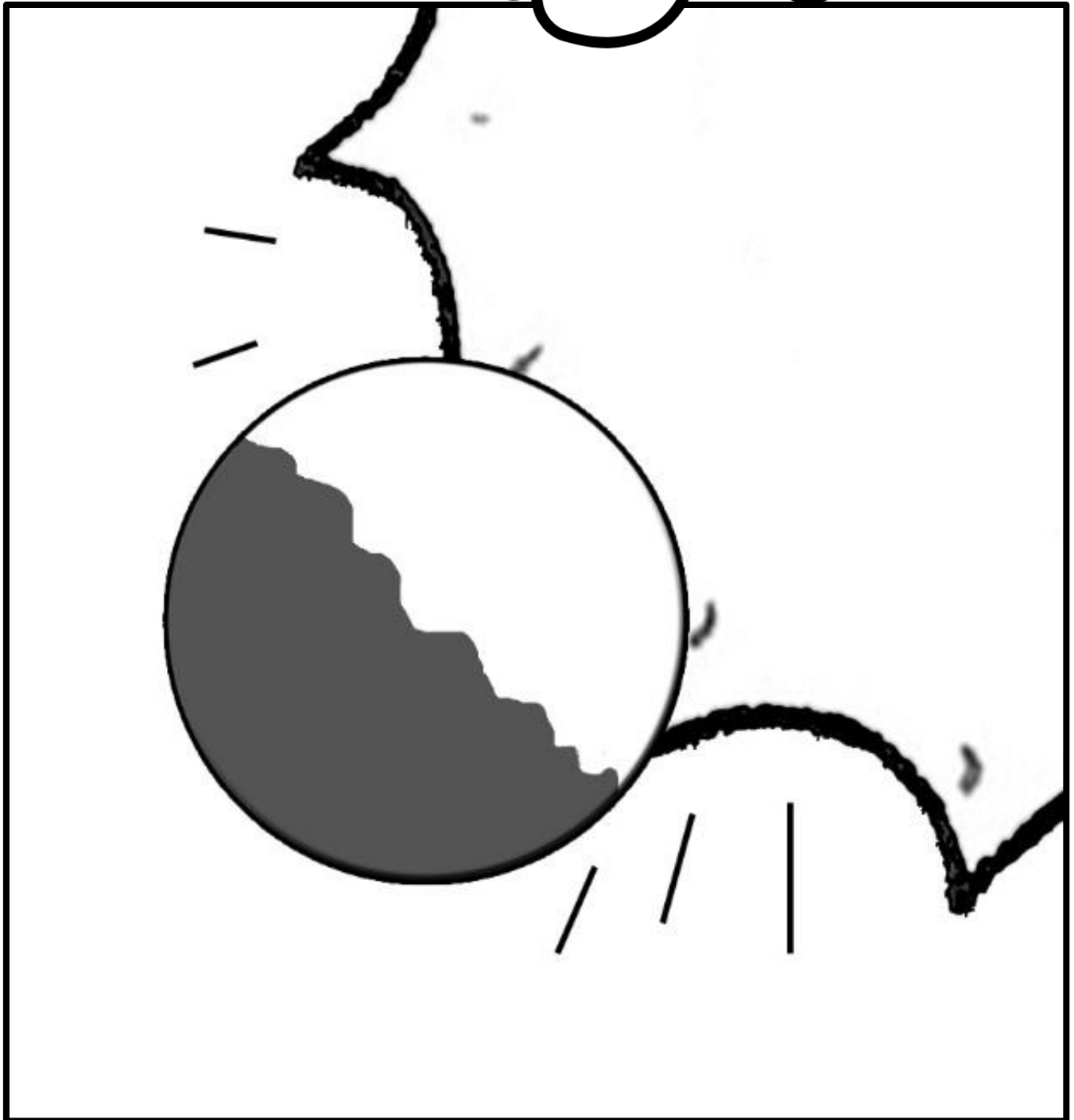

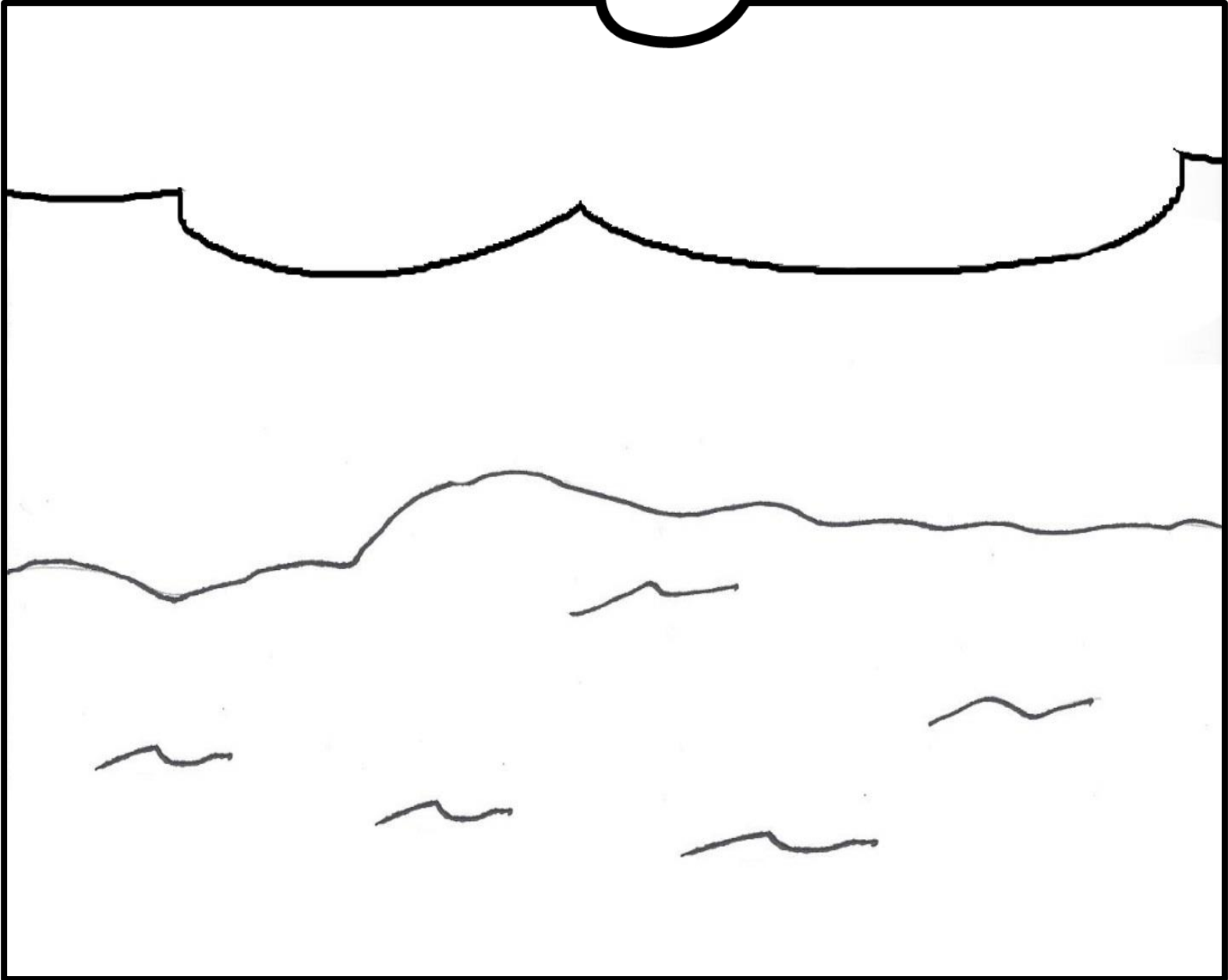

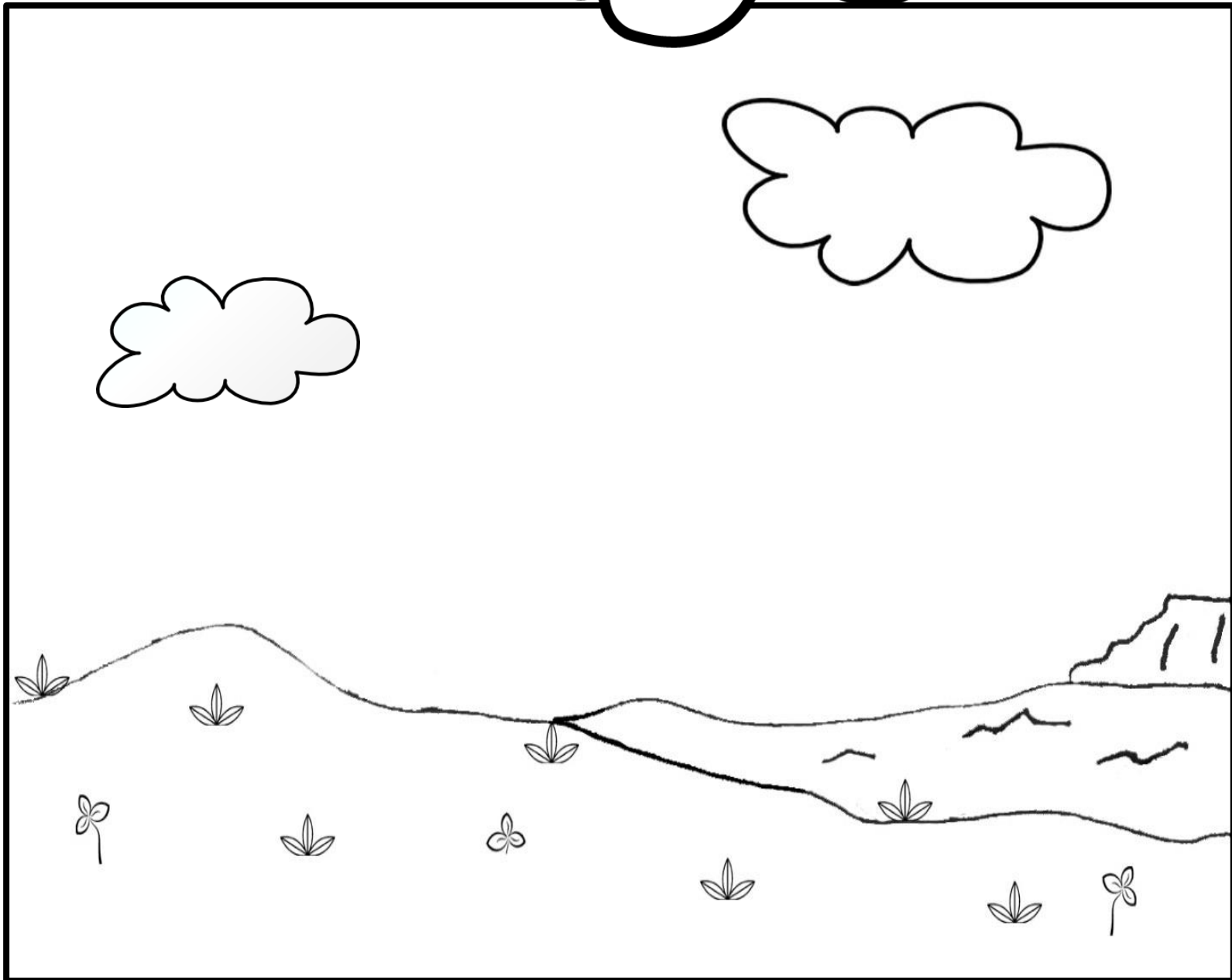
Then Elohim said, Let light be! And there was light. And Elohim called the light, Day. And He called the darkness, Night. And there was evening and there was morning, day one.

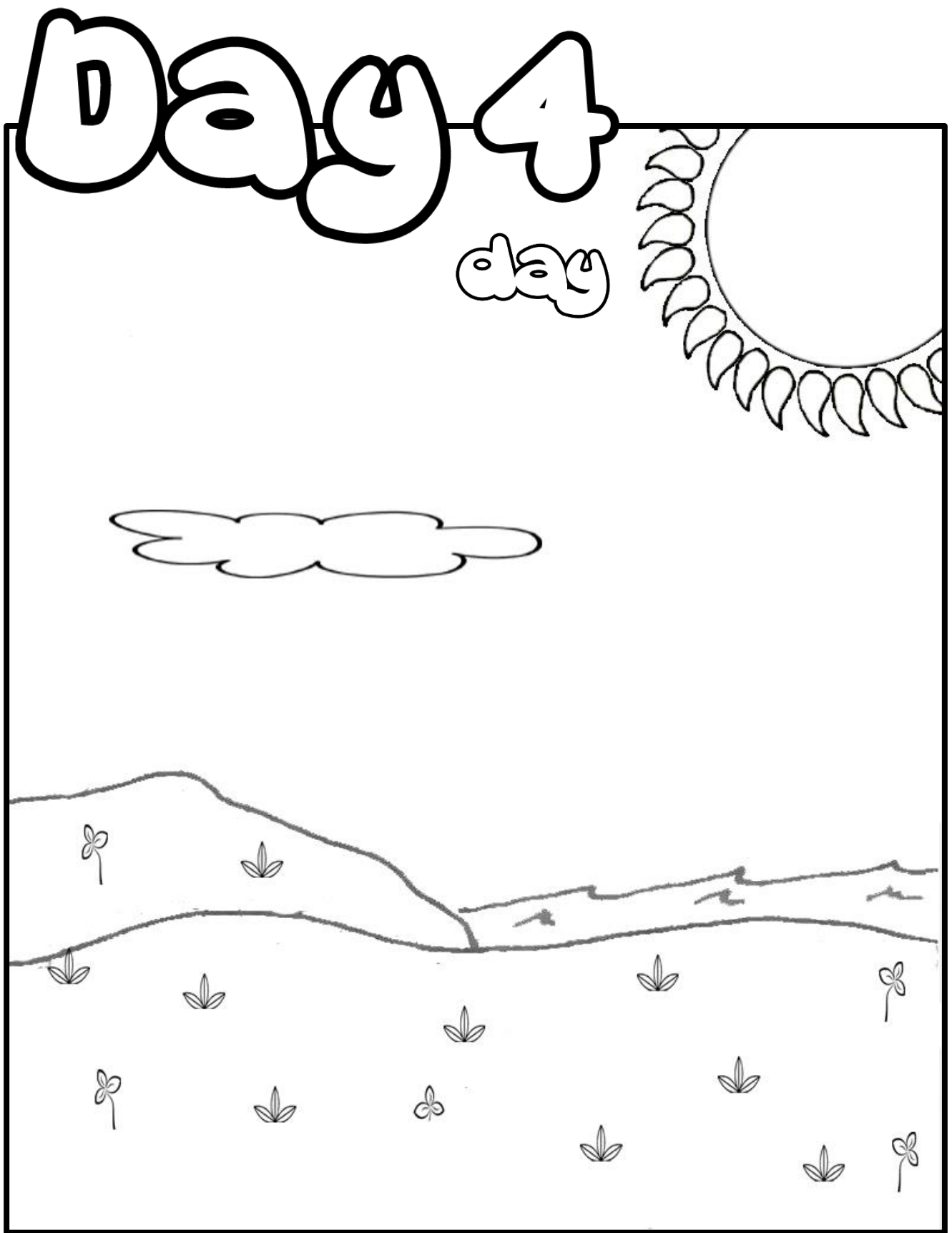

And Elohim made the two great light sources the great light to rule the day, and the small light and the stars to rule the night.

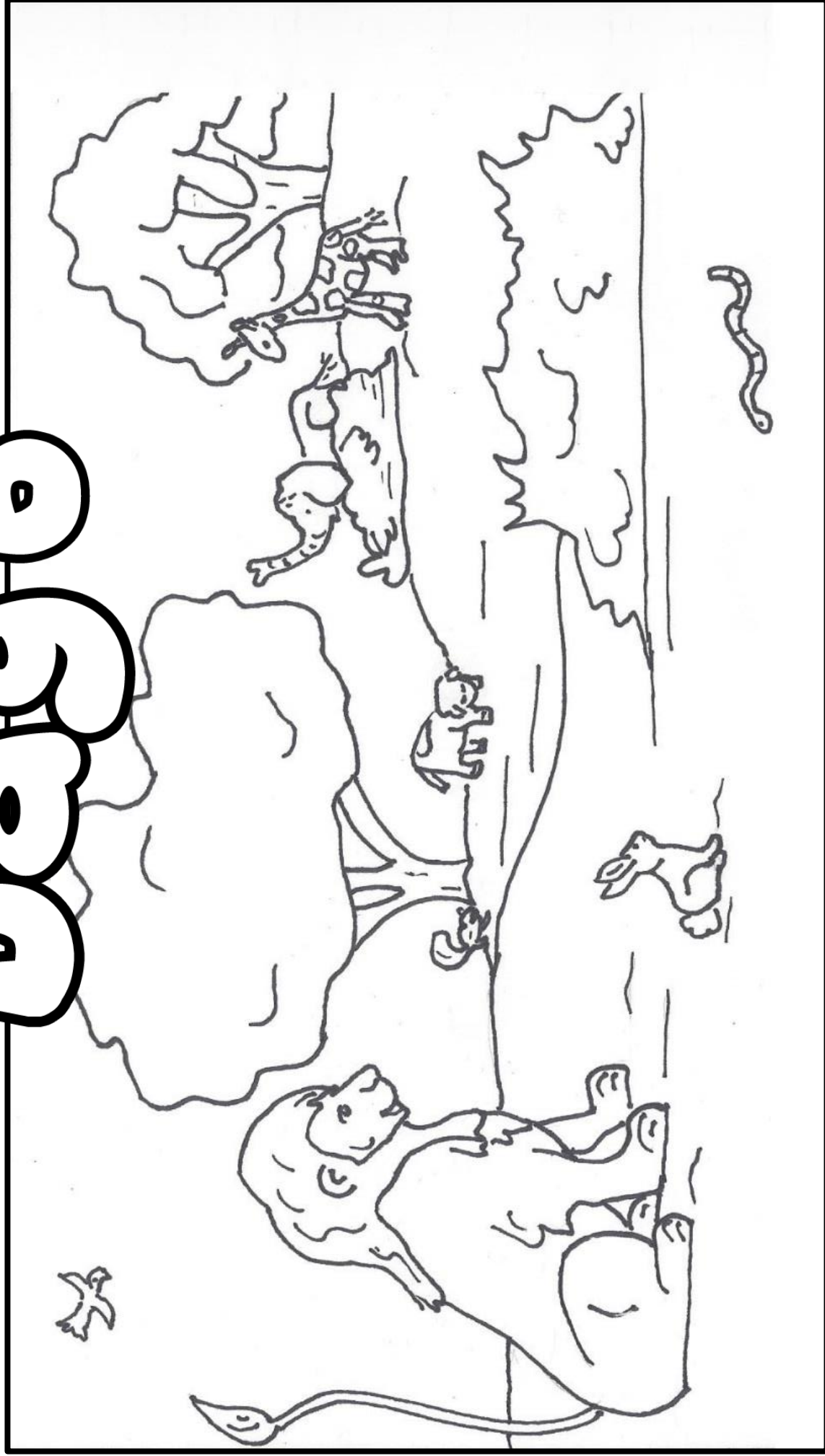

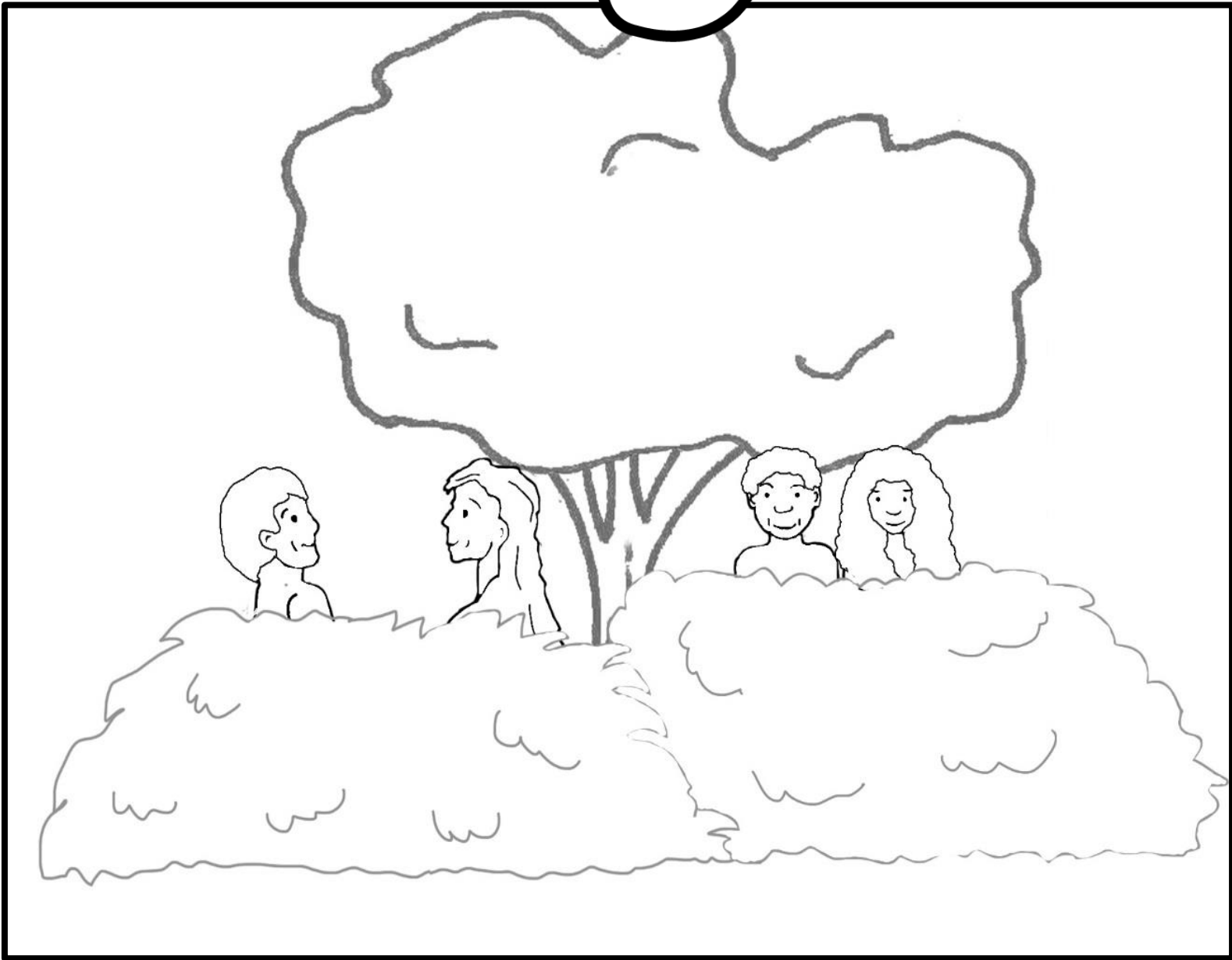

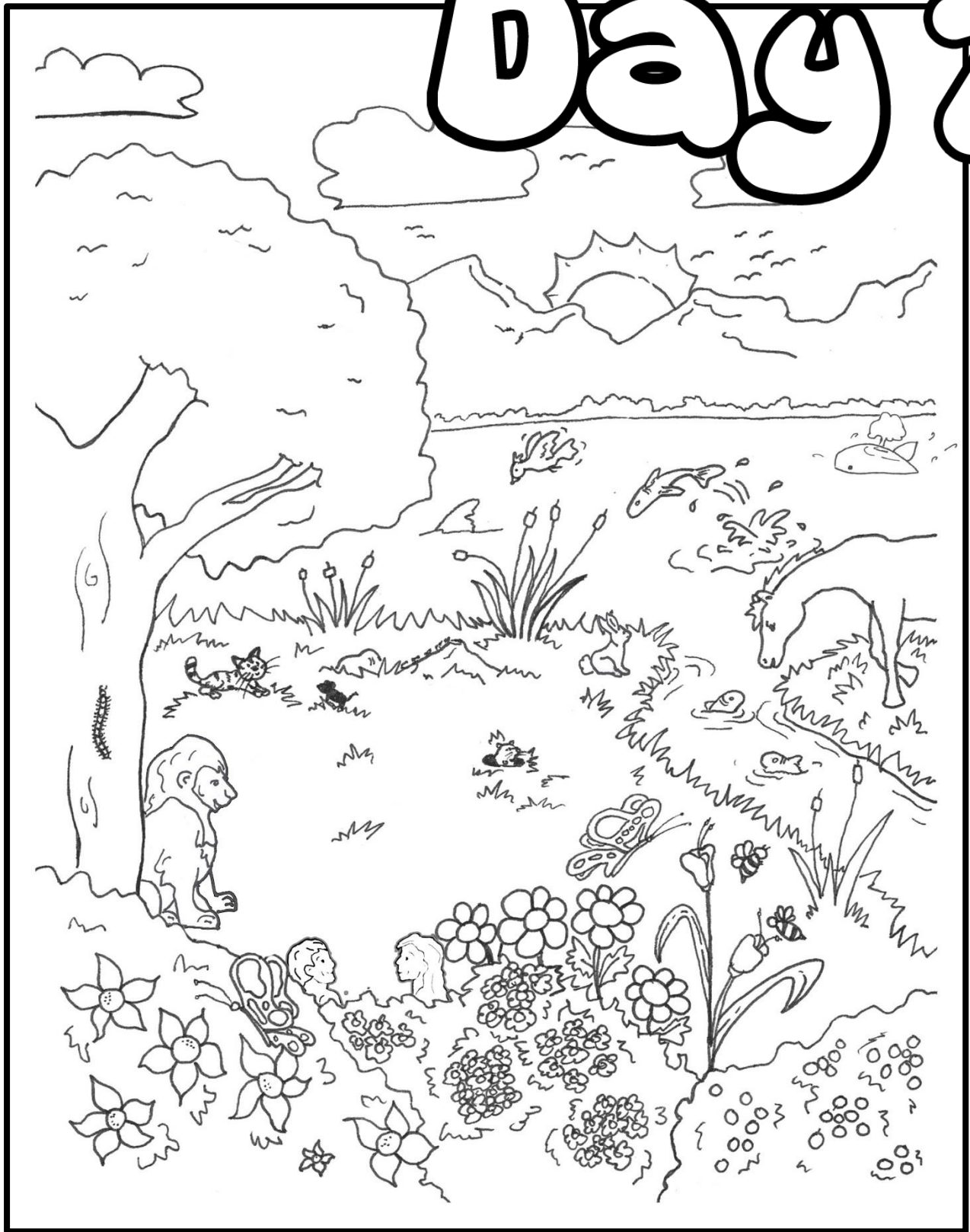
And Elohim said, Let the earth bring forth the soul of life according to its kind cattle, and the creepers, and its beasts of the earth, according to its kind. And it was so.

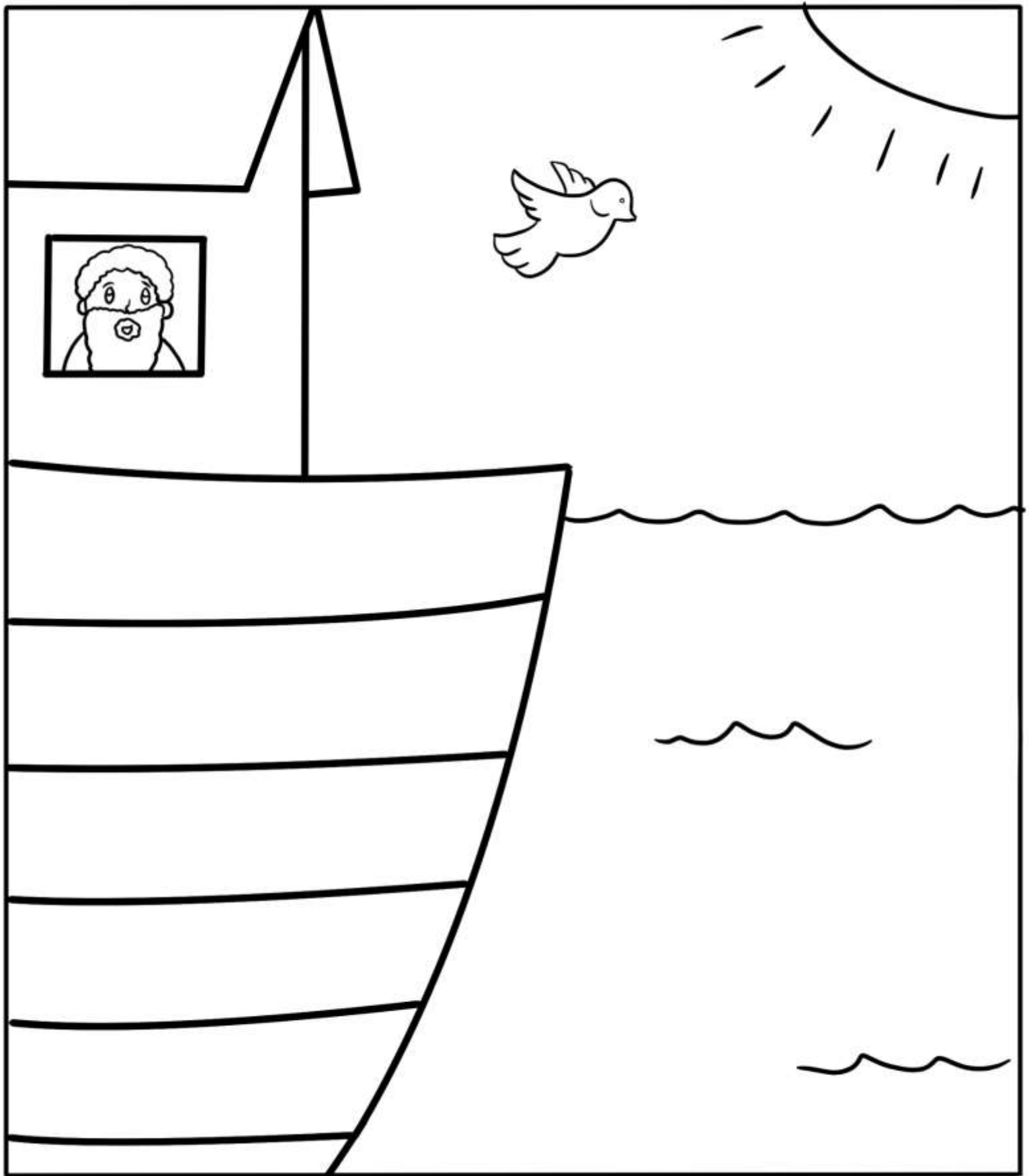
Yahweh told Noah and his family to enter the ark with all the clean animals by sevens and the unclean animals by twos, male and female.



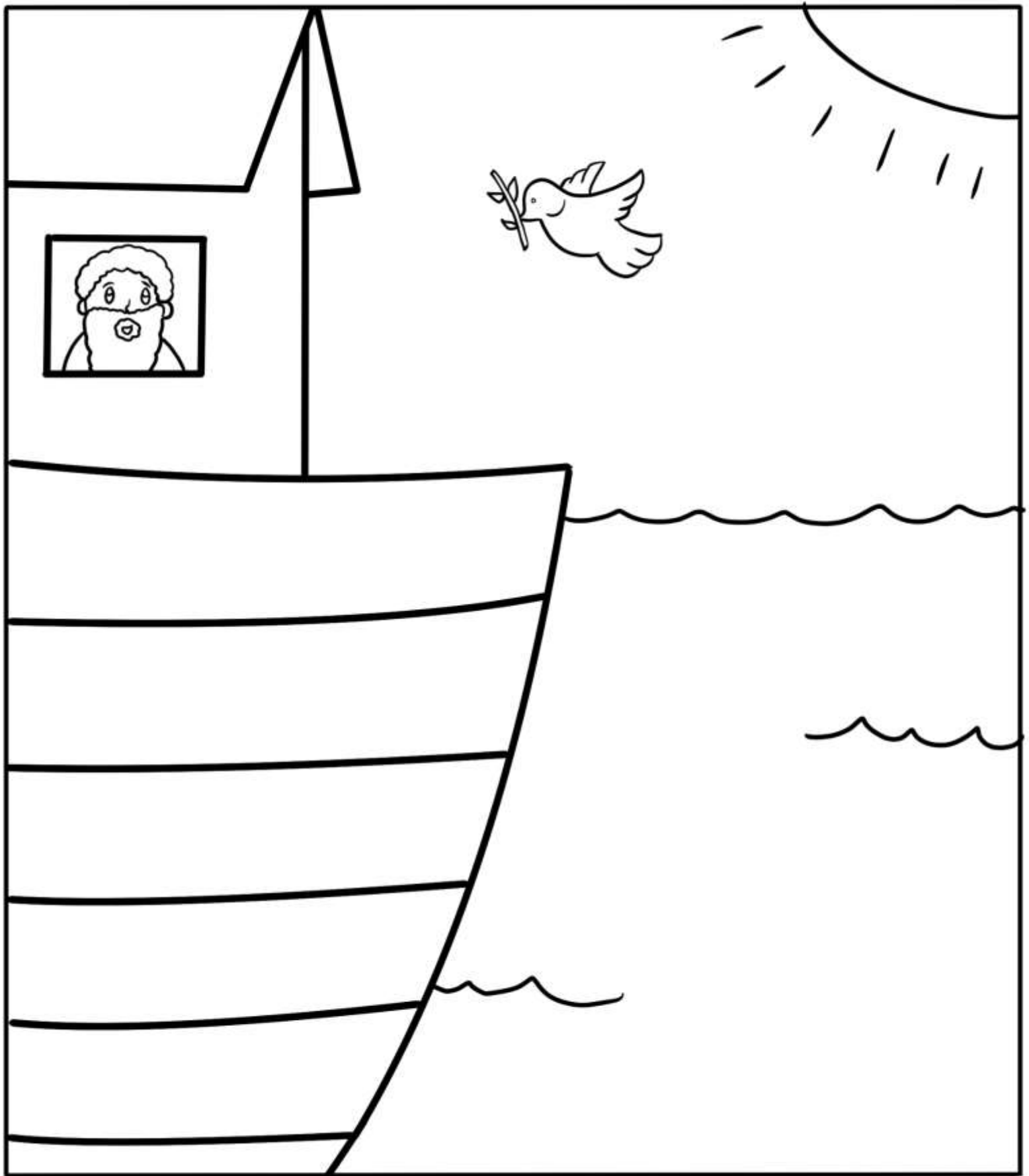
Yahweh shuts the door of the ark and it begins to rain.



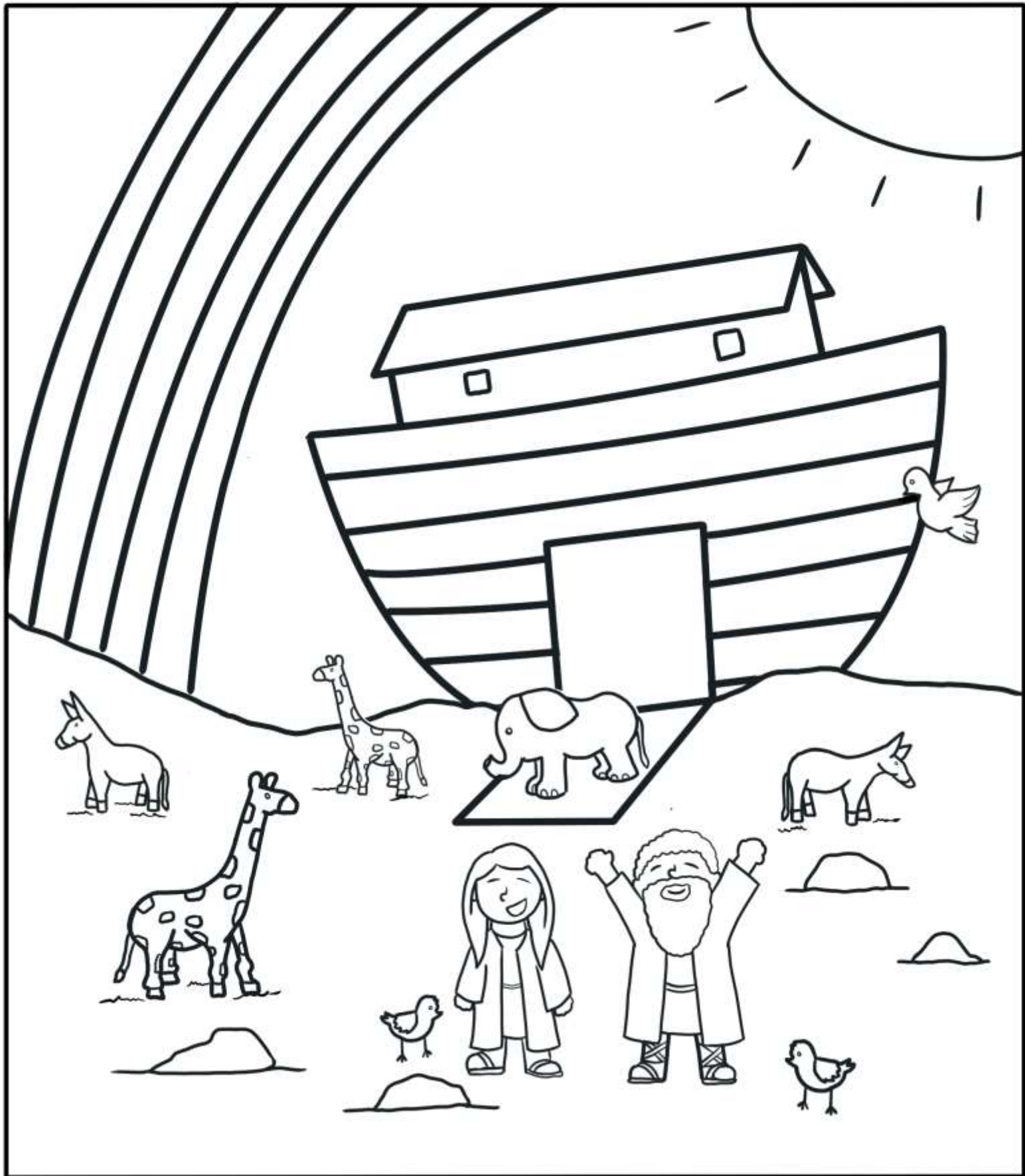
It rained for forty days and forty nights. The waters covered the whole earth.

She returned to him in the evening with an olive leaf.



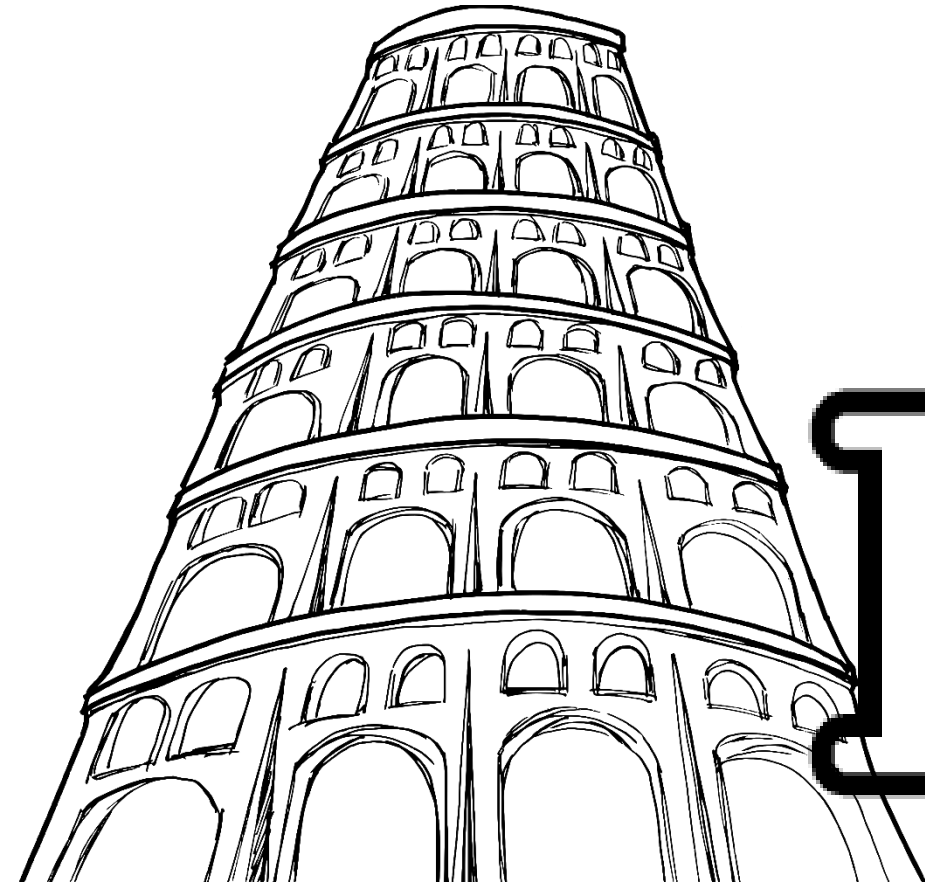
The ark rested on the mountain and Noah and his family went out with all the animals. Yahweh sent the rainbow as a promise to never to destroy the world again with a flood.

Abraham told Isaac Elohim would provide the lamb for the offering.



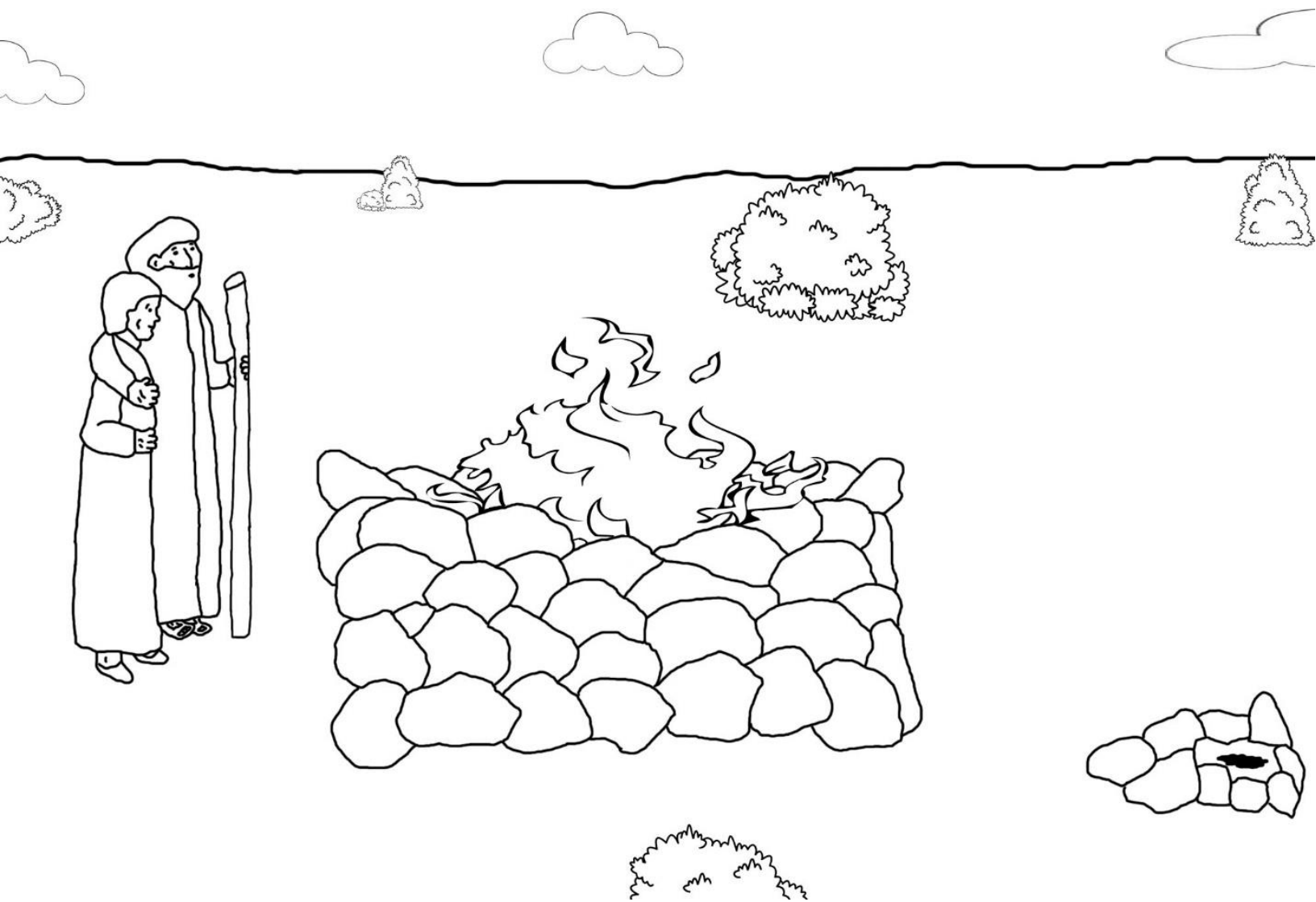
Abraham built the altar for the offering.



He laid Isaac on the altar and stretched out his hand to slay his son.

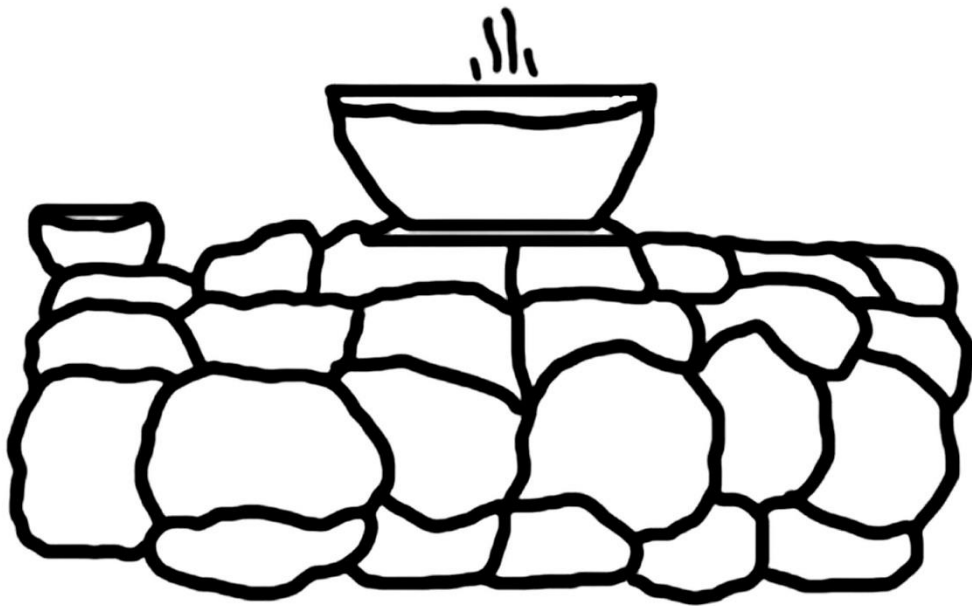

And Paul went down, and bent over him and embraced him, and said: be not terrified, for his soul is still in him

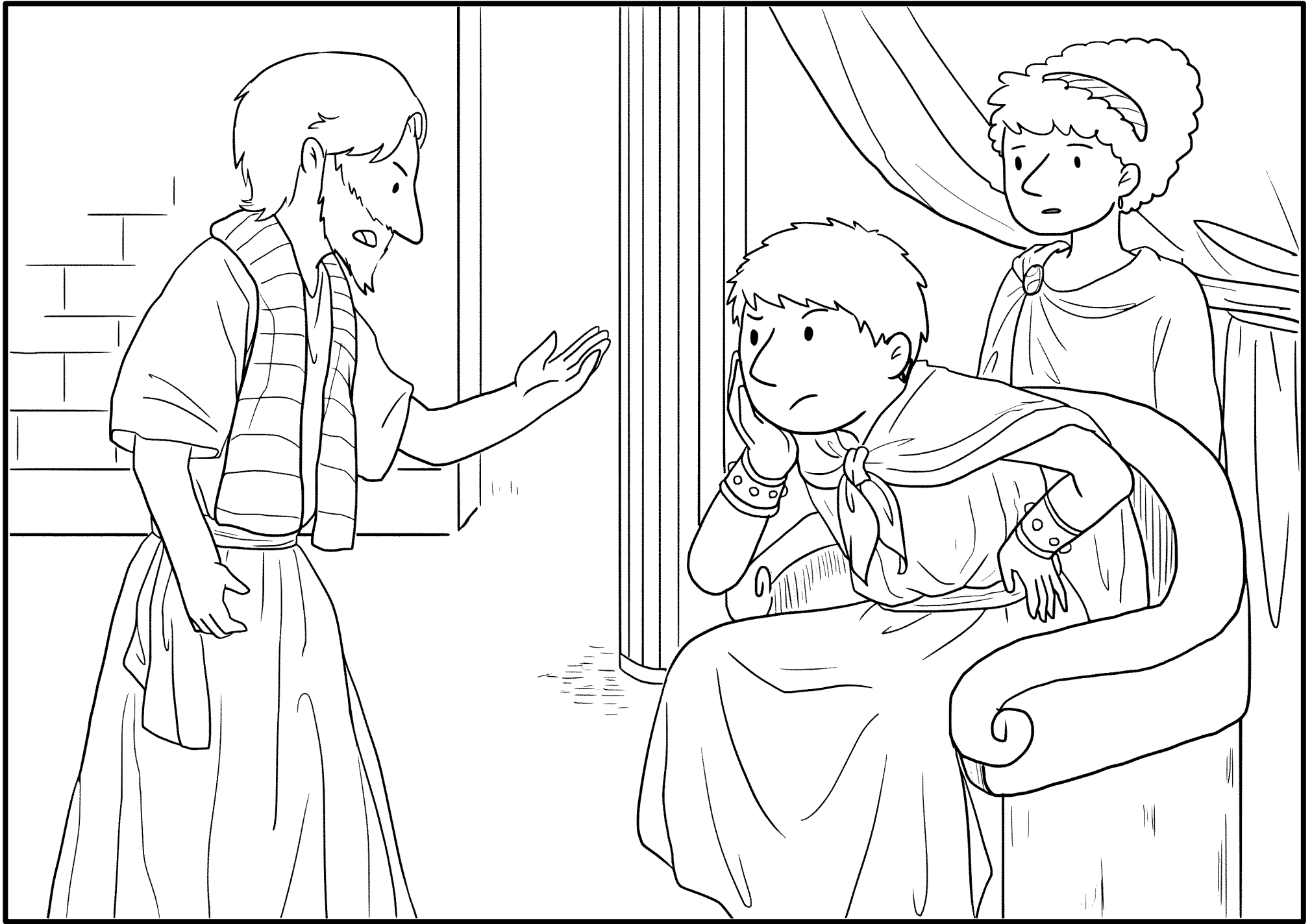

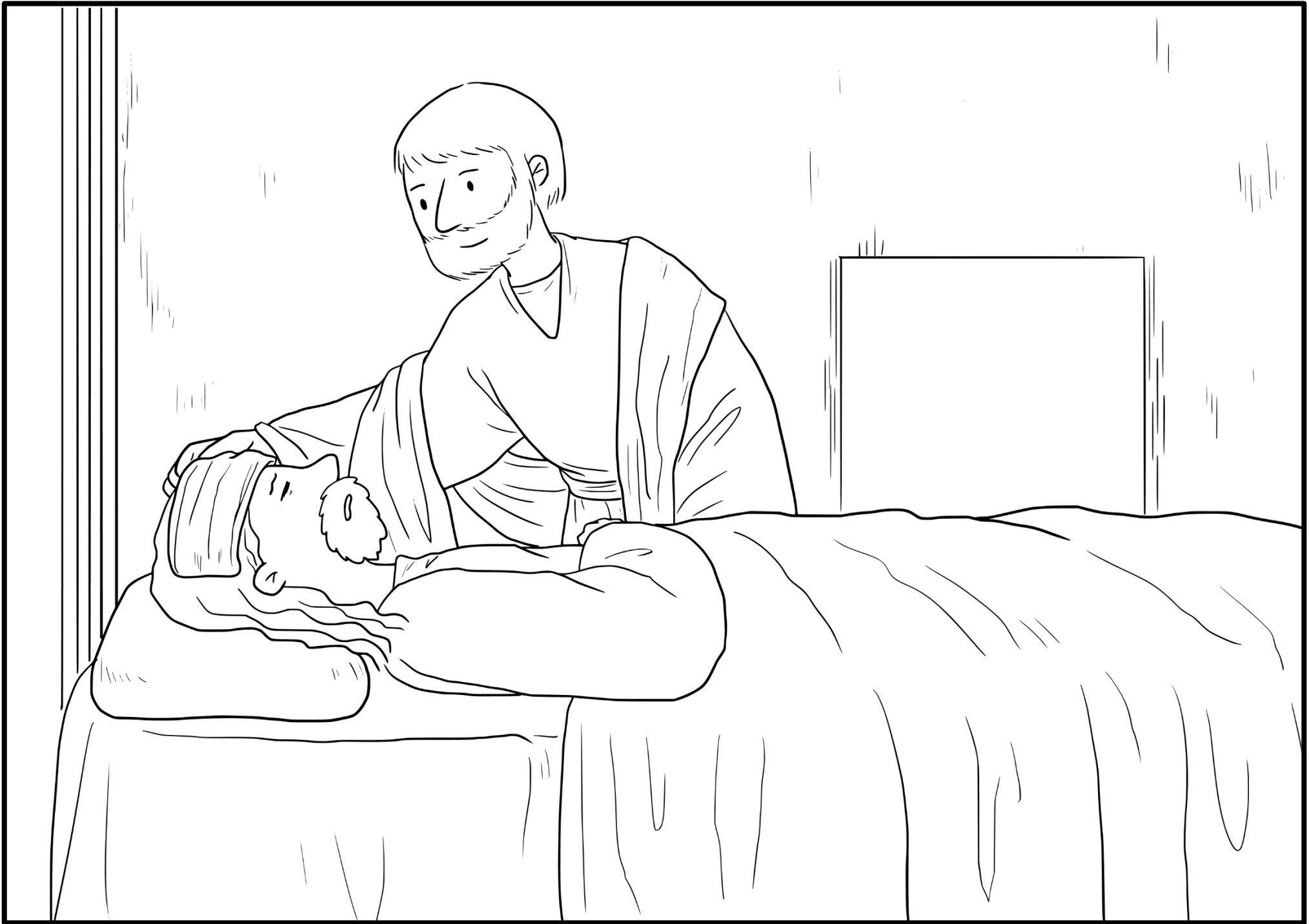




And Paul gathering a bunch of sticks, and putting them on the fire, a snake coming out from the heat fastened on his hand. And when the barbarians saw it hanging from his hand, they said to one another, by all means this man is a murderer, whom being saved out of the sea, justice did not permit to live – Acts 28:3-4

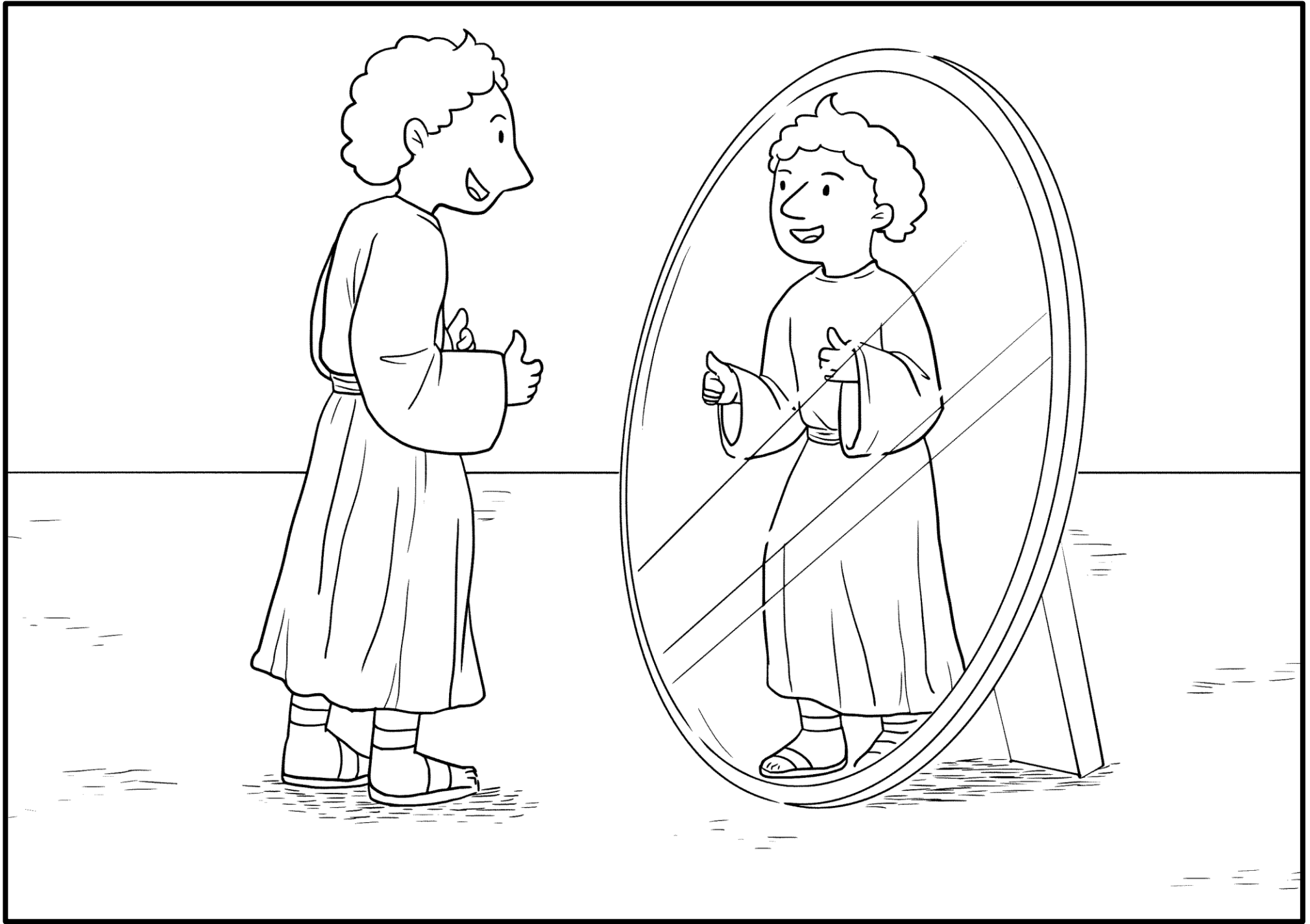

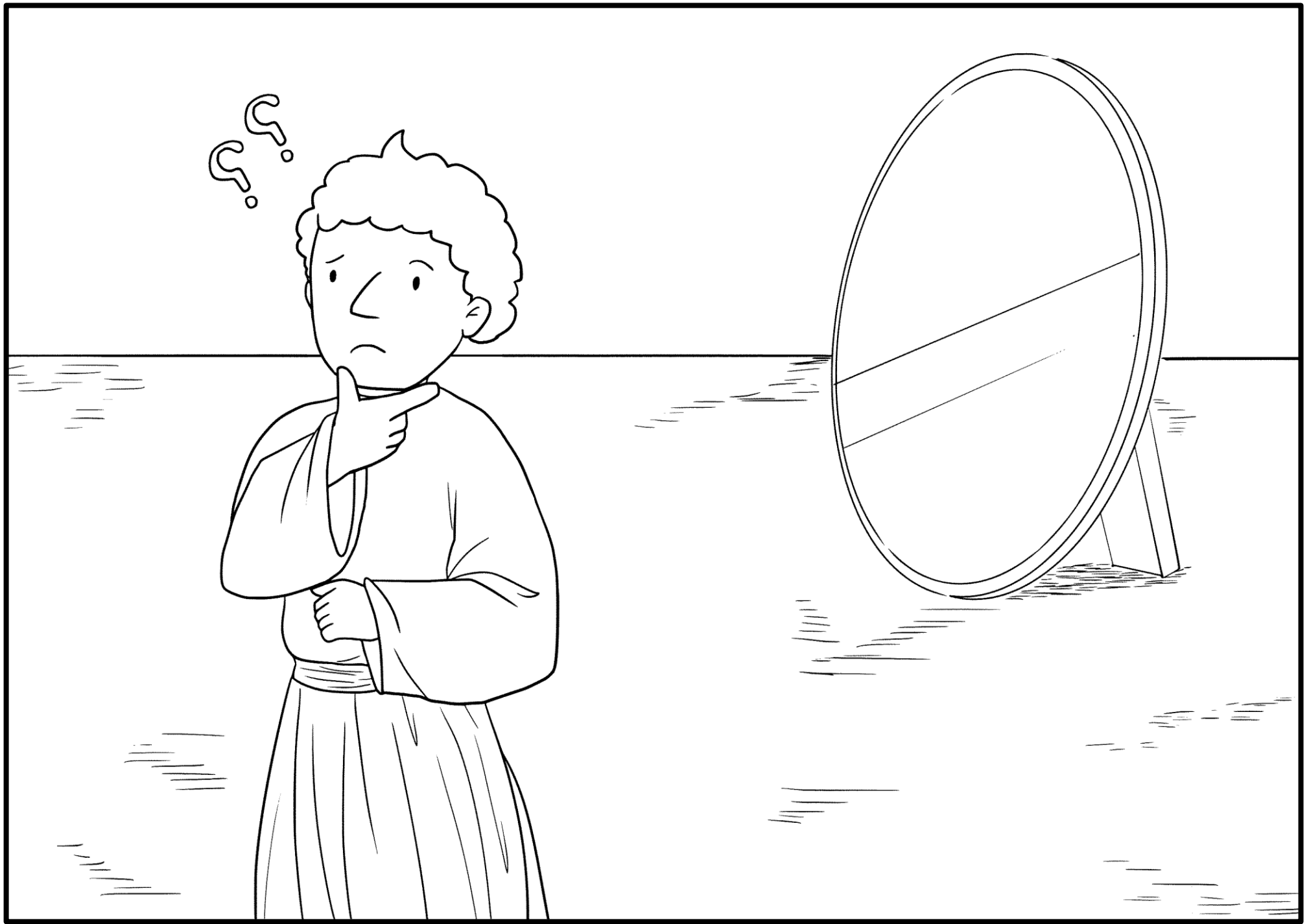

But become doers of the Word and not hearers only, deceiving yourselves. Because if anyone is a hearer of the Word, and not a doer, this one is like a man studying his natural face in a mirror - Jacob 1:22-23



For he studied himself, and has gone away, and immediately he forgot how he looked – Jacob 1:24



But the one looking into the perfect Law of liberty, and continuing in it, this one not having become a hearer of the word which can be forgotten, but a doer of the work, this one will be blessed in his labor – Jacob 1:25
