

The CWL will be hosting workshops to make Sacrifice Beads for Lent.

What are Sacrifice Beads you ask?

As a child, St. Therese Of Lisieux, The Little Flower, carried a string of beads with her to keep track of her little gifts of sacrifice and virtue that she offered to God throughout the day.

To use the beads, as you sacrifice/fast, give alms and/or pray, you move one bead over to record that offering. The 10 beads double as a decade of the Rosary! You can do as many as God calls you to do in a day, a week, or throughout the 40 days of Lent.

We will be making these little strings of beads together, step by step, so if you haven't chosen what to do for Lent this year, why not join us in what may turn into a new tradition, one small sacrifice at a time!
