Logistics:

When parking please be considerate to the good folk of Etal who have welcomed us to their village. We would ask competitors & their associates to park at the allocated parking area detailed on the map in the appendix. Please note we have two races this year and will experience a large volume of people in a very small village, it is essential we minimise the impact on Etal as much as possible. The hall parking is to be used only by race officials and those involved with the hall activities. Do NOT stop or park on the road in front of the village hall – we MUST keep this clear for emergency vehicles. The hall will be open from around 07:45 and is available for changing and a pre-race tea/coffee. The Black Bull pub next door to the village hall will be open from 8:30 and will be serving teas and real Italian coffee. There is a women's toilet in the hall and men's portaloos behind the hall. All riders must produce their full race licence with photo at sign on. Riders will be briefed directly outside the Black Bull on safety points concerning the course. It is compulsory that all riders attend this briefing.

Key information:

- Racing is on open roads. Riders MUST adhere to Highway Code, in particular riding on the left side of the road.
- Please remove cycling shoes at the entrance to the hall so as to not damage the hall floor
- Juniors please ensure gearing is as required under BC regulations. Gear check will be just outside the village hall entrance
- No on-bike cameras in the race e.g. Go-Pro etc.
- There is no feed zone and no handing of feed bottles etc. from the roadside at any point

Event Programme

- No vehicles to follow the race with the exception of the marked official race convoy
- All riders to attend the rider briefing outside the Black Bull pub.
- Race is neutalised from the race HQ to just after the finish line on Ford Bank.
- There is a service vehicle for the race. Even numbers should provide a front wheel & odds a rear wheel. All wheels should be clearly marked for speed i.e 10speed/11speed to aid service.
- Service will only be given on the LH side of the road.
- We give you safety pins for your numbers so use them. Fixing race numbers with double sided sticky tape is unacceptable. Anyone doing so will be charged cost of replacing the numbers.
- NEG riders will be assisting with the field of riders and be communicating with the technical
 officials.

Race information:

Riders should familiarise themselves with the circuit, especially for those who have ridden this race before as we have extended the loop slightly at Ancroft and CHANGED THE FINISH. The race will now FINISH on FORD BANK just before the turn to the village. Immediately after the finish riders turn left into the village. This is a safer place for riders to congregate post-race. A map is in the appendix.

Potholes and other dangers

The bad weather has caused damage to the course. We cannot mark all the potholes but we will mark the major ones. It is the riders' responsibility to be vigilant and ride accordingly. Look out for each other and communicate potential dangers.



The course will be clearly marked with signage and marshaled with high visibility vests as kindly sponsored by our local company Simpsons Malt, a leading producer of Malt for the local Borders area and afar.

KoM/QoM/Prime: There will be a **Reivers Gin KoM/QoM/Prime** award for the first rider over the finish line on the completion of the first lap. The prize will be a bottle of gin kindly donated by **Selkirk Distillery** (cash prize if a junior rider). Please note, a bell will NOT be sounded on the lap preceding the Prime.

At the finish:

After crossing the finish line on Ford Bank riders should turn left into the village to keep the finishing area clear and safe for those still to finish. To get back to the village at race HQ riders should head back down the course, when safe to do so.

Presentation of prizes will take place back to HQ. Please note that the wReivers race commences at 12:30 so your prompt move off the circuit would be appreciated. To take advantage of the refreshments please provide your race licence to the event staff to ensure competitors are given priority.

The prize fund for both the Reivers and wReivers is as follows:

Lost or damaged chips will be charged at £30 – this is not a fine, simply what it will cost us to replace it. There will be marshals with snips at the race HQ.




Appendix Race HQ, car parking and toilets


Detail map and key hazards







Rider safety guide

This race is run under British Cycling's technical regulations and under standard highway conditions therefore you MUST abide by the rules of the road.

Safety

You are not on closed roads and you will face oncoming traffic

Marshals (static or moto)

- Direct riders around the course and warn other road users a race is taking place
- Marshals do not create road closures or make it safe to race on the right hand side of the road

Actions

- You are responsible for your own actions
- Race on the left hand side of the road – do not cross solid white lines and always avoid crossing broken white lines
- Persistent offenders will be penalised (eg disqualification or a fine)
- If necessary the race will be stopped

Responsibility

- Look after each other, behave responsibly and safely
- Do not take unnecessary risks
 your actions could have serious consequences

Think

- About your position on the road
- Rider behaviour is critical to protecting the future of road racing
- We all have a part to play
