Class Materials and Supplies & Dance Attire for Classes

Pre-Ballet I and Pre-Ballet II - Pink ballet slippers, pink leotard and pink tights. Hair way from face in a bun. Short hair should be pinned back on sides away from face. No bracelets, dangling earrings, necklaces or watches.

Ballet Technique Cohort I, Ballet Technique Cohort II, Ballet Technique Cohort III, - Black leotards, flesh tone tights to match skin tone, flesh colored ballet slippers to match tights. Hair way from face in a bun. Short hair should be pinned back on sides away from face. No bracelets dangling earrings, necklaces or watches. Notebook with writing utensil (pen or pencil).

Pointe Technique Classes- Black leotards, flesh tone tights to match skin tone, flesh tone ballet slippers and flesh tone pointe shoes to match tights. Hair way from face in a bun. Short hair should be pinned back on sides away from face. No bracelets dangling earrings, necklaces or watches. Notebook with writing utensil (pen or pencil).

Contemporary – Black leotard, flesh tone tights to match skin tone, black socks, pointe shoes (if you have them). Hair way from face in a bun. Short hair should be pinned back on sides away from face. No bracelets dangling earrings, necklaces or watches. Notebook with writing utensil (pen or pencil).

Dance for Actors – Black leotard, black Jazz pants or black leggings and Jazz shoes or tennis shoes. Hair way from face in a bun. Short hair should be pinned back on sides away from face. No bracelets dangling earrings, necklaces or watches. Notebook with writing utensil (pen or pencil).

Modern – Black leotard, flesh tone tights to match skin tone and white socks. Hair way from face in a bun. Short hair should be pinned back on sides away from face. No bracelets dangling earrings, necklaces or watches. Notebook with writing utensil (pen or pencil).

Jazz – Black leotard, flesh tone tights to match skin tone and Jazz shoes. Hair way from face in a bun. Short hair should be pinned back on sides away from face. No bracelets dangling earrings, necklaces or watches. Notebook with writing utensil (pen or pencil).

Tap – Black t-shirt, black leggings or Jazz pants and tap shoes. Hair way from face in a bun. Short hair should be pinned back on sides away from face. No bracelets dangling earrings, necklaces or watches. Notebook with writing utensil (pen or pencil).

Materials recommended by the Artistic Director for On-Line classes only:

To make the distance learning experience more applicable to the study of dance, I recommend the following upgrades:

- 1. Purchase a portable ballet barre for students ages 9 and above.
- 2. Purchase a tap board or something comparable (plywood or masonite from Home Depot/Lowes)
- 3. Purchase of a Marley flooring for students ages 9 and above. Recommended size should be no larger than 6 feet long and 6 feet wide, considering that your dancer will need to travel horizontally, forward, and backward. Marley floor should be placed on a hard floor surface. Carpeted flooring will not facilitate the process.
- 4. Portable ballet barres and Marley flooring(*Please see suggested websites below with links*)
