Why? These days are Solemnities and Holydays of obligation in Canada and this year they fall on Saturday. According to the liturgical law, they hold the highest rank of celebration. For this reason we cannot celebrate Sunday mass on Saturday evening. Father Peter will celebrate the English mass at 2:00 pm Sunday, January 2nd in St. Claude.

+ Note – after the 2:30 pm. mass on Wednesdays at the St. Claude Pavilion and the 10:00 am. mass in Haywood on Fridays, Father Peter visits and distributes Holy Communion to the shut-ins. If you wish to receive Holy Communion at home, please contact Father Peter at 204-379-2434 or 204-952-4531.

+ COVID-19 restrictions:

- According to the new public health restrictions, we can organize gatherings of up to 25 people plus the liturgical team (celebrant, readers, altar servers, choir. ..).
