
HAPPY GLORIOUS AUTUMN


traveled, these roads curve up the mountain, and at the last turn—Zion! God in full view!





God's Special Time

Only one other time have I known this (1998) ... I am sensing "Kairos" time. "...to save many people alive..." (See Genesis 50:20*)

Kairos (καιρός) An ancient Greek word meaning the right or opportune moment (the supreme moment). Kairos is the time when God acts. The ancient Greeks had two words for time, chronos and kairos. While the former refers to chronological or sequential time, the latter signifies a time lapse, a moment of indeterminate time in which everything happens.

Matthew 11:25 ... "At that time (G2540 καιρός)** Jesus answered and said, I thank thee, O Father, Lord of heaven and earth, because thou hast hid these things from the wise and prudent, and hast revealed them unto babes."

Phase 1 - September 12th he had a bad fall (nothing broken), but he did have a heart attack + brain bleed which kept him in ICU for 3 days. The heart attack and brain bleed require opposite treatments which could have triggered a stroke, or death; and Dad did not want anything invasive done. So ...



Phase 2 - September 15th, too weak to even sit up and eat, he was taken by ambulance to Vasona Creek Rehab where Doug, my wonderful son-in-law, is the Director of Rehab. First thing he did, was to evaluate him. He got Dad out of bed, walked him about 15 feet, helped him back in bed, and from there, he put together an amazing team to help Dad gain his strength back.

During this time, we met 2 men, Dad's roomie Jack, & Lee, a new resident down the hall, both of them well aware that they miraculously survived severe motorcycle accidents. I was blessed to tell them both about Jesus and His plan for their lives. Although Lee had no faith of his own, they both accepted prayer. \o/



nase 3 (in home care) – Dad's been in this phase for about a month now. He has progressed so quickly that he no longer needs Felicia, the "home health aide." He loves seeing the chiropractor 2X a week. Amy, the OT (2X a week) is still working on "good judgment" and balance; Joy, the PT (3X a week), is also working on his balance, and

strength. Krystina RN, once a week. He's approaching Phase 4 (outpatient care) in hopes that he can gain independence again. Until that happens, I'll continue to live with Dad full-time.

As of today, October 26th ... he gets himself ready each a.m., makes his bed and gets his own breakfast. He's very compliant for Amy & Joy, working hard to accomplish each task. He wants to take his walk by himself, but after he tried to take off without his walker (cane only), it was clear that he hasn't got the "good judgment" thing down yet (one of the requirements for

independent living). Along with balance and strength, good judgment is now the greatest need. I just now (October 26th) took this pic of him in his favourite chair ... he says <u>"Thank you!"</u>
