Mission

Responsibilities of Volunteers - Examples

- Check children in and out
- Help children pick out books when needed
- Monitor children and animals
- Punch cards and let children choose from the treasure chest
- Set up and clean up as need be
- Pass out goodie bags and parent packets
- Make sure all children and families have left before the closing of the event
- Make sure all of LfC's belongings are picked up & put back in the volunteer cart and the cart is locked

Event and Time Commitment

Duration of Term: 12 months (will do a two-month training – 2 events)

Event Commitment:

- Once a month for 3 hours
- Arrive 15 mins. before events start
- Stay up to 15 mins. after event concludes
