## My Testimony of the Demonstration of the Joy of God and the Oil of Gladness

One night, while sleeping soundly in my quiet and almost dark-filled room, where the moon-light slightly shined through my bedroom curtains, I was awakened by the <u>amazing and awesome sensation in me of the Holy Spirit, being the Holy Ghost of the LORD God and of the LORD God and of the LORD Jesus Christ the Almighty, according to Acts 1:8; Acts 2:29-36; Luke 11:13; I Corinthians 2:1-16; Hebrews 5:5-14; I John 2:23; I John 5:9-11, 20; and Revelation 1:8, <u>gently rising up within me</u>; however, it was not felt as intensely or for as long a period of time as my first experience. During that same year, 1977, my first experienced of this spiritual sensation lasted, as I recall, up to one or two minutes, a truly heavenly, holy, sacred, and divine experience!! This second time I'd experienced this sensation, it was much more brief, lasting only five (5) seconds, or so.</u>

In reference to my first experience of the rising up of the spirit of the LORD in me, explained in more detail below, being one with God and with Christ, I later learned through the holy scriptures, that this experience was ultimately the fulfillment of the will of God, according St. John 6:38-40, in reference to I Thessalonians 4:14-17, as in reference to Romans 12:1-2. Gathered together and in sum, the holy scriptures have made known to me the revelation of the mystery of Christ and of his will fulfilled, in reference to Isaiah 40:9-14; Romans 12:1-2; Romans 16:25-27; Ephesians 1:1-20; Ephesians 2:1-22; Ephesians 3:1-20, and truly PERFORMED in me, in reference to Jeremiah 33:14 and Luke 1:45-53, 72-79-note Ezekiel 12:25-28 and Ezekiel 13:1-9—as within the holy apostles and prophets, in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, according to I Corinthians 2:1-16, specifically verse 4 and Hebrews 2:4, thereby, confirmed and interpreted by the holy scriptures, according to Isaiah 44:23-28, specifically verses 24-26 and II Timothy 3:14-17, comparing spiritual things with spiritual, in reference to I Corinthians 2:1-16, specifically verse 13; and Hebrews 5:5-14; as I have been instructed and inspired to prove and to make all men see, again, in reference to Acts 7:35-39, (in reference to Exodus 3:11-14); Romans 12:1-2; Romans 16:25-27, as in reference to Psalms 87:5 and Romans 8:1-17, 28-39); Ephesians 3:1-21; specifically verse 9; I Thessalonians 1:4-10; Revelation 17:14, 17-18, as in reference to II Timothy 2:15, and again, II Timothy 3:14-17, as recorded in this book, 'The Lamb's Book of Life', in which God Almighty inspired me to write and testify of him and of HIS MIGHTY ACTS AND WONDROUS WORKS; HIS

**<u>DOINGS</u>**, according to Psalms 145:1-13; Isaiah 12:1-6; St. John 14:20-21; Acts 1:8; Revelation 5:1-13, by the standard set up by God, according to Isaiah 49:22-26, as in the following:

Chapter 5/Part I: My Testimony of the Demonstration of the Resurrection of the Spirit of Christ Rising Up and Lifting Me Up Within My Body 5-1.a Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation;

Chapter 5-1/ Part II: RMy Testimony is the Evidence Jesus Christ Is Come Again the Second Time Unto Salvation and Raised Up the Church, which was Manifest in My Body, at the Last Day! (*Note Chapters 4 and 5/Part 1*) Regarding my testimony(ies), in reference to **II Timothy 1:7-11 and II Timothy 2:15**, as I have been instructed to show myself approved unto God rightly dividing the word of truth. Therefore relating to and in agreement with the holy scriptures through my testimonies that are in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, according to I Corinthians 2:1-16, I have learned God Almighty has given me a new name, Zion, according to Psalms 87:5 and Psalms 132:13-18; The LORD our righteousness, according to Jeremiah 33:14-16, as in reference to Jeremiah 23:3-6; II Corinthians 3:2-6, 17-18 and new Jerusalem, according to Revelation 3:12, as prophesied and testified of by the Word of God, the Holy Scriptures, as they do of Christ, according to St. John 1:1-16; St. John 5:39-44 specifically verse 39; and II Timothy 3:14-17, specifically verse 16.

Therefore, regarding my testimony, as mentioned above, in reference to **Zion**, of whom I am called by the name of the Lord due to my spiritual witness of God and of Christ come to pass and experienced in me, in reference to Deuteronomy 18:5, 7, 13, 15-22, comparing spiritual things with spiritual, according to I Corinthians 2:1-16, specifically verses 1-5, 13, note the following Holy Scriptures that confirm my word and sayings, as in reference to Isaiah 44:23-28, specifically verses 24-26 and Romans 3:1-4, as in reference to Romans 2:28-29: For it is written: Psalms 87:5; Psalms 132:13-18; Micah 4:1-8; Micah 5:1-4; St. Matthew 24:27-28, 30-31; St. Matthew 25:31; St. John 6:38-40; Romans 11:25-26; Romans 12:1-2; I Corinthians 4:1-21; I Corinthians 15:21-28, 34-58; II Corinthians 3:2-3; II Corinthians 4:1-15; Hebrews 9:28, in reference to I Corinthians 1:18, 24; Revelation 17:14, 17-18; and Revelation 21:1-27. *In reference to verses 2, 9-22, regarding the bride of Christ, of whom my sons/seed and I are, note, I Corinthians 7:8-9; I Corinthians 11:9-10; and Ephesians 5:25-27, 32.* 5-1.a Additional Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation

So, again, in reference to my testimony of the joy of God and the oil of gladness, being in reverent awe and admiration of Christ actually glorified in me, as he has blessed me with all spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ, as I later learned through the Holy Scriptures, according to Ephesians 1:1-20, specifically verse 3 and II Thessalonians 1:10, as I witnessed this sensation / feeling, according to Hebrews 5:5-14, specifically verse 14, which was not of my own control or will, but of the will of God, as in reference to St. John 1:13; of being spiritually led within by the marvelously gentle rising, glorious and gloried Spirit of God and of Christ manifest within me, according to Romans 8:14-16; I Corinthians 15:43; and Ephesians 2:1-10, specifically verses 6 and 10, as "in demonstration of the Spirit and of power", according to I Corinthians 2:1-

16, specifically verse 4, to some extent fearing the unknown, not knowing what next would occur, and yet still trusting in the Lord! In the midst of rising up high in my Spirit with godly fear, in reference to Hebrews 12:28, *note verse* 29, I began to praise my heavenly Father, according to St. Matthew 6:14, 26, 32, my Abba Father, according to Romans 8:15-16!

Next, to my amazement, without exaggeration, as with all of my testimonies of God and of Christ, another most unusual and extraordinary thing began to occur and come to pass in me, in reference to Deuteronomy 18:15-22, specifically verses 21-22, in a way I have never experienced before. Amazingly, in a miraculous, spiritual, celestial and heavenly way, my heart began to beat unusually strong and intense! Then, wonderfully, the beating of my heart gradually and increasingly grew more and more intense, until finally my heart, literally increased with such amazing warmth and passion! As I could actually feel my heart as it softly and fervently pulsed, as with fluid/blood, and throbbed tenderly, delicately, and gracefully within me! As this same sensation of the beating of my heart occurred when I witnessed and experienced the demonstration of the love and grace of God and of the Lord Jesus Christ in me, according to St. John 14:1-21, specifically verse 21! I laid my hand against my chest to confirm that this feeling was actually physically occurring and not my imagination. As a result, I could literally feel my heart beating fervently and amazingly strong within me where that particular area of my heart felt ardently and gloriously warm, as with God's own heavenly and holy fire and glorious passion expressed and demonstrated in me, as in reference to Isaiah 31:9, (in reference to Psalms 87:5 and Psalms 132:13-18); St. Matthew 3:11; I Corinthians 2:1-16; and I Corinthians 3:12-23, specifically verses 13-16.

Wonderfully, at this point, as my heart was beating strongly with such zeal and fiery passion, suddenly, out of the blue, I felt unusually, yet **truly** happy! That is, in wonder and amazement, I felt **spiritually** happy, as never before, until I became aware that I was literally smiling, touching my face to confirm this sensation of happiness was actually occurring on the outside of me as well as within me! Normally one is made happy due to a happy thought that enters into one's mind. For example, a little girl becomes emotionally happy because her father brought her a gift. However, in regards to my testimony, as I have explained, my mind was on nothing except that which I was experiencing and witnessing!

Eventually, this emotional and physical feeling of spiritual happiness grew increasingly intense, surpassing and excelling even beyond the physical expression of happiness on my face! Amazingly, when I smiled less, this feeling of great spiritual, happiness was still greatly demonstrated within my heart!

Suddenly, this amazing feeling of **God's own joy**, manifest within my heart and soul, grew and increased with so much intensity, that is, his very own zeal, excitement, and enthusiasm, that, to my pleasant surprise, my heart and soul wonderfully climaxed with even more abundant spiritual and heavenly joy, far beyond the natural, human experience of happiness and joy! Shortly following this truly amazing experience of heavenly joy, I experienced and felt, literally, the pouring forth abundantly and richly 'the spiritual oil of gladness', in reference to Psalms 45:7 and Hebrews 1:9! It is important to note I Corinthians 15:20-28, 34-53.

That is, I experienced the physical and literal sensation of a warm, thick spiritual liquid pouring forth as oil graciously and abundantly in my heart and simultaneously experiencing this physical and literal sensation of heavenly and spiritual gladness; one among many spiritual blessings in heavenly places in Christ, in reference to Ephesians 1:3, as in reference to Ephesians 2:6, again, recorded in this book, 'The Lamb's Book of Life', in which the Lord God Almighty inspired me to write and testify of him come in me, according to St. John 14:20-21; Acts 1:8; and Revelation 5:1-13, as in reference to Isaiah 30:8 and II Timothy 3:14-17, as in reference to Romans 8:1-17, 28-39; and Revelation 21:27, Chapters 4-8, 10-15; My Spiritual Testimonies of Christ and of God with Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation! Truly, this was God's and Christ's, in reference to Acts 2:36 and 1 John 2:23, own pure joy and delight powerfully shown within my heart "in demonstration of the Spirit and of power", in reference to I Corinthians 2:1-16, specifically verse 4; Galatians 1:11-12, 15-16; Colossians 1:25-27; **I Thessalonians 1:4-10**; and I Peter 1:5-13, (note Romans 11:25-27 and Romans 16:25-27)! For it is written:

St. John 17:13 And now come I to thee; and these things I speak in the world, that they might have my joy fulfilled in themselves.

**I Peter 1:8** Whom having not seen, ye love; in whom, though now ye see him not, yet believing, ye rejoice with joy unspeakable and full of glory: 9 Receiving the end of your faith, even the salvation of your souls.

10 ROf which salvation the prophets have inquired and search diligently, who

prophesied of the grace that should come unto you. St. Matthew 13:10-17

Let me make emphatically clear, in comparison, God's spiritual joy exceeds natural joy far, far greater in intensity and in degree! In fact, there is no comparison. As the sensation of the LORD God Almighty's joy is greatly physical as well as emotional, in reference to Psalms 45:7; I Corinthians 2:1-16, specifically verses 1-5; and Hebrews 5:5-14! And again, for example, the

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joy that a very poor person would feel as a result of winning a very large sum of money, would not be in any way equivalent to the sensation/feeling of the LORD God's joy. For God's joy is truly, heavenly, holy, pure joy, which is, truly "joy unspeakable", in reference to I Peter 1:8-10, specifically verse 8! As the Lord's joy is amazingly abundant, and intensely felt and experienced, without the use of any drugs or alcohol, including the mind altering and detrimental drug, marijuana and the like.

The same night, following this experience, I witnessed, in a dream, being face-to-face with the LORD Jesus Christ, as similarly testified of in Chapter 4-1.1/ Part II, briefly mentioned below, following my testimony of the demonstration of light and power revealed within my heart and soul, also briefly mentioned below. As occurring in my dream, while in the presence of the Lord Jesus Christ, looking into each other's eyes, I witnessed joy and the glory of God as light that shined and glowed in his face, according to II Corinthians 4:6, simultaneously experiencing his own spiritual and heavenly joy exactly, as to the same degree, as he expressed on his face. That is, his joy expressed on his countenance was at the same time demonstrated in my heart and soul; being a reflection or mirror image of one another; the feeling or physical sensation of being one with him, according to Acts 2:25-28, (note verses 29-38); St. John 14:13-21; St. John 15:11; St. John 16:14-25, (note verses 7-11, as in reference to Isaiah 11:1-5); St. John 17:13-26; I Corinthians 15:20-28, 34-53, specifically note verses 28 and 47; II Corinthians 4:1-7, specifically verse 6; Hebrews 5:5-14, specifically verse 14, (as in reference to Isaiah 41:20-21); Revelation 22:4-5, as in:

Chapter 4/Part I: RMy Testimony of the Demonstration of Light and Power Revealed Within My Heart and Soul: It is Come to Pass the Son of Man, who is Jesus Christ, is Come in Glory and Power!: 4-1 Additional Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation, \*Numbers 16:1-7, as in reference to God's chosen, they who are holy and whom his has caused to come near, as in reference to I Thessalonians 4:14-17, that is, 'Zion', of whom I declare to be, (note II Timothy 2:15), as the scriptures testify of me, as they do of Christ, and my seed/children, beginning with my two adult sons, Ian Dusan Bounds and Phillip Anthony Bounds, as in reference to St. John 5:39, such as Psalms 87:5; Psalms 149:1-9; Isaiah 31:9; Isaiah 44:1-8, 21-28; Micah 4:1-10; Micah 5:1-3; St. Matthew **16:27-28**, (in reference to St. Luke 17:21); St. Matthew 24:26-27, 30-31, (in reference to verse 31, 'his angels', note I Corinthians 11:9-10; and Ephesians 5:25-27, 32, as in reference to Revelation 19:5, 6-9) (note St. Matthew 13:10-17); St. Matthew 25:31; St. Mark 9:1; St. John 14:1-29; St. John 16:7-25; Romans 16:25-27; I Corinthians 3:1-18; I Corinthians 4:1-21; II Corinthians 3:1-6, 17-18; II Corinthians 4:1-15, specifically verse 6; Ephesians 3:1-21; Colossians 1:25-29; Revelation 12:1-17; Revelation 17:14, 17-18, in reference to Daniel 7:9-27, as in reference to the following:

Chapter 5/Part I: My Testimony of the Demonstration of the Resurrection of the Spirit of Christ Rising Up and Lifting Me Up Within My Body 5-1.a Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation;

Chapter 5-1/ Part II: RMy Testimony is the Evidence Jesus Christ Is Come Again the Second Time Unto Salvation and Raised Up the Church, which was Manifest in My Body, at the Last Day! 5-1.a Additional Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation;

Chapter 4-1.1/ Part II: The Revelation of Jesus Christ in a Dream and Vision: My Testimony of Being Face-to-Face with the LORD Jesus Christ as I Witnessed Joy and Glory on His Countenance with <sup>R</sup>Joy Demonstrated in My Heart and Soul! Acts 2:25-36 4-1.1a Additional Scriptures and Confirmation and Interpretation;

I have experienced this spiritual joy of God and of Christ within me again; however, not as intensely as this first time, in addition to being simply happy that God is my LORD, in reference to Exodus 20:1-6 and Psalms 144:15, as in:

Chapter 4-1.7: Rejoicing with Songs, Praise, and Thanksgiving, For Salvation and the Kingdom of God is Come Within My Heart: 4-1.7a Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation!

Please note that from the time of my natural birth, prior to the year 1977, I never knew or even heard of these spiritual things, the deep things of God, in reference to Isaiah 42:16; Jeremiah 33:3; and I Corinthians 2:1-16, that is, until the year 1977, of which I began to experience a series altogether truly amazing, including precious, beautiful, wonderful and marvelous, heavenly and celestial wonders occur, as in the kingdom of heaven/ the kingdom of God come within me, according to St. Luke 17:20-21 and St. John 14:1-21; my true and authentic spiritual testimonies of God and of Christ, come to pass in me, in reference to Psalms 77:11-12; Psalms 105:2; Psalms 145:10-13; I Peter 2:1-15, as in reference to Deuteronomy 18:5, 15-22, especially note verse 22; Isaiah 8:18-20, actually over a period of twelve (12) months. Note Revelation 22:1-5, specifically verse 2, again, comparing spiritual things with spiritual, again, according to I Corinthians 2:1-16, specifically verse 13.

This is the testimony, meaning, evidence and or proof, in the Bible, a) the tables of the law: Exodus 25:16, (as in reference to Exodus 20:1-17; in reference to Moses, note Acts 7:35-38, as in reference to Deuteronomy 18:5, 15-22; also in reference to the 'tables of the law', note St. Matthew 22:35-40 and Hebrews 8:1-13, specifically verses 1-5, 10-13; and in reference to the 'testimony', note Isaiah 8:17-18, 20; Acts 17:22-31, specifically verses 27-28; Romans 9:1-33, specifically verses 15-16, 23; I Corinthians 2:1-16, specifically verses 1-5; Hebrews 9:28; and Ephesians 3:1-21, in reference to the 'tables of the law' and to the 'testimony', note Isaiah 8:17-18, 20, as in reference to Isaiah 31:9, (note St. Matthew 3:11 and St. Matthew 12:39),

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b) the precepts of God, (in reference to Psalms 119:4-7 and Isaiah 28:9-23, 26, 29), of Christ was confirmed, (meaning, proven and demonstrated to be a fact and experienced), in me, in reference to I Corinthians 1:6, as in demonstration of the Spirit and of power, in reference to Deuteronomy 18:5, 15-22, (especially note verse 22); I Corinthians 2:1-16, specifically, verse 4; and Hebrews 5:5-14, specifically verse 14, therefore, being the testimony and witness of Christ and of the holy apostles and prophets of Christ, in reference to St. John 3:1-13, 31-35, (in reference to verse 13, note I Corinthians 15:20-28, 34-55, specifically verses 28 and 47; Ephesians 2:1-10; Ephesians 4:4-13); St. John 8:12-19; I Corinthians 2:1-5; Ephesians 2:20; Ephesians 3:1-21, specifically verse 5; I John 1:1-5; Revelation 1:1-6; and Revelation 19:10, as in Chapters 4-16: My Testimonies of Christ and of God: Scriptures of Confirmation and Interpretation, therefore, confirmed and interpreted by the holy scriptures, in reference to Isaiah 44:6-8, (note verses 9-11), 23-28, specifically verse 26; Romans 16:25-27; II Timothy 2:15; II Timothy 3:14-17, in reference to verse 17, 'the man of God', note Romans 8:1-17, 28-30, specifically verses 28-30, and thereby proven to be true, as we are true witnesses that he is, truly, come manifest in our flesh, in reference to St. John 14:1-21, specifically verse 21, (note St. John 16:7-11); I John 4:2, 4, 13-14, (note verse 3), as God himself is our witness, in reference to St. John 5:31-44; Romans 8:16; Hebrews 2:4; Hebrews 10:15-22; I John 5:6-12, 20; and Revelation 1:1-8, as in reference to Acts 5:29-32; Romans 3:1-4, as in reference to Romans 2:28-29, (note Revelation 3:9); Romans 16:25-27, (in reference to verse 26, note II Corinthians 4:6); Hebrews 5:5-14; I Peter 2:1-15, specifically verse 9, in reference to verses 7-8, see Luke 16:15-16; St. John 5:30-44; I Corinthians 1:1-31; and Revelation 3:9! For the mystery of God is finished, according to Revelation 10:7, as in reference to St. John 6:39-40; Romans 11:25-26; Romans 12:1-2; I Thessalonians 4:14-17, specifically verses 16-17; Revelation 11:15; and Revelation 17:14, 17-18, as in reference to Daniel 7:9-27 and I Corinthians 15:20-28, 34-58!
