BREAST CANCER in IDAHO

2022

Incidence 2015-2019

6,435 malignant breast cancers diagnosed among female Idahoans, and 51 malignant breast cancers diagnosed among male Idahoans. Approximately 1 in 3 cancers diagnosed at an advanced stage.

- For every 1 woman who lives in an affluent Idaho community and dies of breast cancer, there are
 2 women who live in communities with higher poverty and die of breast cancer.
- Idaho ranks 49th of 53 U.S. states and territories and the District of Columbia for breast cancer screening (2020 BRFSS).
- ~72 in 100 female Idahoans women aged 50-74 have had a screening mammogram in the past 2 years.

Mortality 2015-2019

1,099 female and11 male Idahoans died of breast cancer.

Women aged 50 to 74 years and at average risk for breast cancer should get a screening mammogram every other year.


Prevalence on July 1, 2019

Over **9,300** Idahoans are living with a breast cancer diagnosis received in the prior 10 years.
